BRIEF INFORMATION ABOUT THE ACTIVITY (CRITERION NO. - ):

TOPIC/SUBJECT OF THE ACTIVITY	Intellectual Property Rights
OBJECTIVES	The importance of IPR can not be overlooked in the present world. Intellectual Property is the creation by a human mind, through its intellect, whereas Intellectual Property Rights are the protection granted to such creations by way of law.
METHODOLOGY	An advertisement placed on the college website attracted students from within the college as well as other colleges of Delhi University. Some joined from colleges outside of DU also. Classes were held on Saturdays as well as holidays, usually for two hour duration, followed by question-answer sessions and discussions. Speakers who were experts in the field of IPR were invited to give these lectures.
OUTCOMES	Highly interactive sessions were held between the students and the experts, Mr.Hari Subramaniam and Ms.Dahlia Sen Oberoi, over twelve weeks. Students gained a lot of information about IPR and benefitted from the innumerable case studies that were discussed in these classes. This was beneficial for the young learners as they could appreciate that it was important to protect their own creative ideas and also not to indulge in plagiarism.

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### Objective of the add on course

The main aim of this course is to sensitize young minds to the rapidly emerging concept of who is the rightful owner of a creation and what is the legally correct manner of using that creation. The high point of this course is that it holds equal relevance to students from Sciences, Commerce as well as Humanities.

### The Concept of Intellectual Property

Intellectual Property is what a human mind creates through its intellect, whereas Intellectual Property Rights are the protection granted to such creations by way of law. The broad objective of most intellectual property law is to promote progress. By exchanging limited exclusive rights for disclosure of inventions and creative works, society and the patentee/copyright owner mutually benefit, and an incentive is created for inventors and authors to create and disclose their work.

A **Patent** is an exclusive monopolistic right granted by law to an inventor for their invention giving them the right to exclude others from making, using, selling, offering to sell, and importing an invention for a limited period of time, in exchange for the public disclosure of the invention.

A **Trademark** is a visual symbol, a word, device, three dimensional shape, signature, name, label, numeral, combination of colours used on goods or services or other articles of commerce to distinguish it from the other similar goods or services originating from different sources.

An industrial **Design** constitutes the ornamental or aesthetic aspect of an article barring the technical aspect. A design may consist of three-dimensional features, such as the shape or surface of an article, or of two-dimensional features, such as patterns, lines or colours.

**Copyright** is a legal term used to describe the exclusive rights given to the creator for its original work which can be categorized under different sections such as literary, artistic works, cinematographic etc.
