TOPIC/SUBJECT OF THE ACTIVITY	Image of the Year 2020 – A Theme Based Photography Contest
OBJECTIVES	The Department of Biochemistry focuses on holistic education of our students. METHODOLOGY	Image of the Year Contest is a theme-based photography contest wherein students submit their original photos on the given theme. The best picture is selected through online voting of the department via google forms.
OUTCOMES	The Theme for IOTY 2019-2020 is Chaos. Order and Chaos are integral facets of life and both have their unequivocal importance. Imbalance of either leads to disharmony in life. This theme is complementary to "Autophagy", the theme of Expressions 2019 magazine. Autophagy is a scientific concept that signifies cellular death, thus IOTY enabled students to amalgamate learning through different lenses. With this essence, 14 Students submitted their entries and the winning photos were published in the annual departmental magazine. A total of 51 students and faculty voted for the best photo.


