1. Background:

An inaugural lecture for Involucre, Botanical society, Sri Venkateswara College, was organised on 12th November, 2021. The inaugural lecture was followed by the launch of a toolkit for "JIER", the community outreach program initiated by the department of botany.

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, the whole event was held virtually on the google meet platform. The event commenced at 3 a.m. and was concluded by 5 p.m. Second- and third-year students of the B.Sc. (Hons) Botany course participated in this event. Our principal, Prof. C. Sheela Reddy graced the occasion with her presence during the event.

2. <u>Reception and Event:</u>

3. <u>Future scope:</u>


