REPORT

On the 31st of October 2022, **Rasagya**, the Chemical Society, of Sri Venkateswara College organized a Skill Enhancement Workshop on the topic: "**How To Write And Publish A Spotlight Article**." The Editor-in-chief of SynOpen, Prof. Laurence Harwood, and the Acquisition Editor of Thieme Scientific and medical publisher, Dr. Rohit Bhatia were the guest speakers for the event. Prof. Laurence Harwood joined the workshop in online mode.

The workshop commenced with the welcoming of the guests by Dr. Mercy Jacob who presented a sapling to Dr. Rohit Bhatia as a token of appreciation and gratitude. Prof. Sharda Pasricha, Convener, Chemical Society, delivered the welcome address and also thanked all the faculty members and students for their active contributions in making the event a success. Dr. Akanksha Gupta introduced the speaker to the audience.

Dr. Rohit Bhatia started the lecture by briefly explaining about the reputed international publishers, SynOpen and how this international journal contains millions of citations and different articles. He talked about the various advantages of publishing the spotlight articles, especially by undergraduate young minds. According to him, this exercise could motivate students to further pursue their higher studies and research in Chemistry and its allied disciplines.

Citing extremely relatable and useful examples, Dr. Bhatia introduced a complete cycle of various parameters familiarizing the audience with writing a research article, following a correct format and optimizing the research paper properly. Strongly condemning plagiarism, he also talked about the do's and don'ts while writing a review article.


Prof. Laurence Harwood cleared the doubts of the students by showcasing practical solutions for the same and inspired the students to publish spotlight articles and mini reviews.

After the lecture, Dr. Rohit asked the students to make small working groups, chose a suitable title from any recent topic of importance in Chemistry and attempt writing first paragraph of a proposed spotlight article. They were given 2 hrs time for this. Each review article was subsequently presented by the participants and Dr. Rohit Bhatia critically assessed them highlighting the main shortcomings and guiding them as to how those articles could be improved to a further extent. Towards the end, he gave inspiring notes for motivating the young


