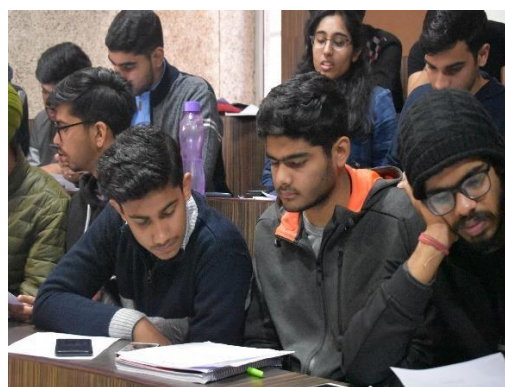

## PROOFS

Mock Stock being the most fascinating event of consortium'19 experienced a footfall of around 50 teams from different colleges like ip , jamia islamia , ddu , dtu and various colleges of Delhi University. Also students from as far as Vishwa Vidyalaya came specially to attend this event .The event was conducted in the T1 room. This mock stock was divided into 3 rounds.



Rounds 1 and 2 were the flagship rounds of a mockstock in which the participants were provided with a set of news and a number of companies to invest or short sell in. If the teams predicted that the price will rise they were supposed to invest in that particular share however if they thought the price would fall they were supposed to short sell i.e. sell at a higher price to buy later at a lower price. The teams were provided with a budget of RS 10 lakhs to invest and a separate budget of RS 3 lakh to short sell. The competition was not only about predicting whether the news will have a positive impact or not but also how to manage their funds and invest in the share who was most likely to give the maximum profits.



On the basis of the profits, top 12 teams were taken to the next and final round which was kind of a live trading session. For this the teams were allotted individual brokers who were supposed to bring their trade calls to the exchange (whose role was played by the event head). The Share that was chosen was India Bulls housing finance. The reason behind choosing this was the volatility and the frequency of changes in its price. The brokers used to bring the position that the teams wanted to enter and the exchange would then confirm it to them if the market price had struck their price. The

main purpose was to let the participants have an insight of how the stock market works and to test their skills to think on their feet because as soon as they would send their position the market price would already have changed.
