The webinar was held virtually on 15th November, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. through the Zoom platform. The Guest speaker for the same was Mr. Sambhav Jain Co-founder, FamPay, a teen focused Fintech Startup | Forbes 30 under 30 | IIT-R Alumni |

The Webinar started formally at 6:30 P.M. with a spiritual note of seeking blessings of Lord Shri Venkateswara; Saraswati Vandana and welcome remarks by Mr. Ajit Singh, Convener of the Extension Activity Committee and esteemed faculty in the Department of Commerce. He welcomed Dr. S. Venkata Kumar (Vice-Principal, SVC, DU), TIC – Dr. Shruti Mathur; faculty members of the Department of Commerce, SVC and students from the SVC and other colleges. He informed the audience that the SVC is basking in the 60th year of its glorious academic journey and marked 2021 as the year of Diamond Jubilee Celebration (1961-2021) and recently SVC has been ranked as the Number 11 amongst the colleges all over India by NIRF Ranking 2021. Further, the proceedings were taken over by a Final year student, Mr. Narayan Sharma from B. Com (H) 3rd year.

The Vice-principal – Dr. S. Venkata Kumar was invited to give brief insights into the Department of Commerce and welcome the guest speaker. He emphasised on the holistic education of students and the need for being financially independent to be at pace with the growing world. She added that the whole department is committed to the welfare and growth of students.

The theme of the session was "*Financial Literacy*". The key resource person was *Mr. Sambhav Jain*, who delivered an insightful, knowledge enhancing and interactive session on financial literacy and the growing significance of it in the fast paced dynamic world.

He started with a brief insight of the norms and perception prevalent regarding financial literacy and sufficiency in Indian society specifically and critically analysed it with Western society's perception. He intrigued the audience by starting from the smallest examples of pocket money to the fact how students generally run errands to compensate for their expenses in order to be less financially reliant on parents. Moreover, he briefly mentioned about his journey of inception of the idea of FamPay while he was in his institute and the factors that triggered the inception of the same. He mentioned the importance of research and survey before acting on his entire plan of setting up FamPay and gave the audience significant insights into the same. Besides, he talked about the entire process of setting up FamPay, starting from arranging funding by being one of the 180 ideas getting offered funding at Y Combinator, USA to ensuring the sustenance of it with multiple marketing and promoting strategies. Lastly, he ended on the note of highlighting the utter significance of being financially literate and taking active steps to become financially independent

It was an interactive webinar with a question and answer session at the end to clear the doubts of the students. The Question-Answer session was moderated by the moderator **Narayan Sharma**. He played an instrumental role in moderating the session between key resource person and audience. The questions belonged to a wide spectrum across the arrangement of funds for start-up and the way to improve perception around financial sufficiency. The resource persons replied positively to the queries of students and ended the session with advising the students to have a proactive approach in learning.

Around 103 students led the webinar to be a great success. The webinar ended with the vote of thanks by **Ms. Devki** and she expressed gratitude to each and every one who made this webinar successful by his or her gracious presence.


