

TOPIC/SUBJECT OF THE ACTIVITY	Comfluence'22 (Speaker session, SOS, Ek Break toh Banata hai)

Date: 31st October, 2022

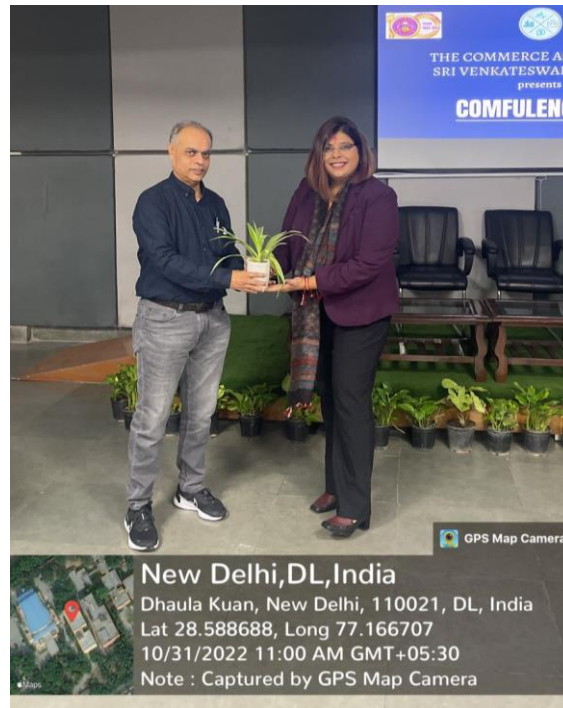

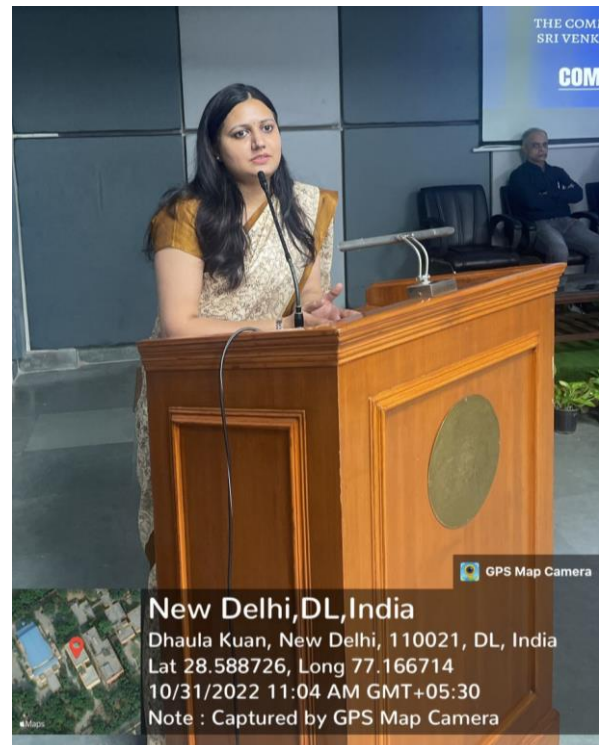
