#### **Activity Report**


The Economics Association of Sri Venkateswara College held its 2<sup>nd</sup> Expert Talk on 25<sup>th</sup> October 2016. We were honoured to have Shri S.V. Ramana Murty, Deputy Director General, National Accounts Division, CSO, and Government of India, as our 2<sup>nd</sup> keynote speaker in this series. The session started with the lighting of the lamp, an auspicious tradition observed at the start of every Association event. This was followed by a brief introduction of our keynote speaker by our faculty advisor, Dr. Brahma Reddy.

Shri SV Ramana Murty began this interactive session on "National Income Estimation in India" by encapsulating the various factors that are essential while calculating the income of a country. He further explained the nuances of his job at the Central Statistics Organization and took his curious listeners closer to the onground reality. In a country with a billion plus population, carrying out statistical surveys is an extremely challenging task. Through his presentation, he meticulously showed us the different methods by which the CSO collects its data. He laid emphasis on securing credible information from the samples of such surveys as they are of great importance to the growth figures of the nation. In a way, he ended up giving a valuable lesson to all the budding economists in the audience and encouraged them to take up their individual research.

India's high growth rate was the primary topic of discussion in the Q and A session. Questions demanding the authenticity of India's growth numbers were catapulted at Shri Ramana Murty, and he patiently countered each argument. The burning question though was the role of housewives and their work's inclusion in the GDP of the country. A maid is paid for her services but a housewife isn't. Shri Murty pointed out this stark reality with a famous quote in macroeconomics, i.e. "if you marry your maid, the GDP shrinks".

The session ended with our Principal, Dr. Hemalatha Reddy presenting a token of appreciation to our esteemed speaker. Shri S.V. Ramana Murty's systematic illustration to a vast topic like national income certainly helped his audience to get a grip of the current economic situation.
