SUMMARY REPORT

The Department of Electronics, Sri Venkateswara College was invited by the Sangeet Natak Akademi – the apex body in the field of performing arts in the country—to visit and witness the five-day long festival “*Jyotirgamaya*”, commemorating the Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav as well as the World Music Day (21st June). The Department was invited to attend the third day of the festival which consisted of an art exhibition by the renowned Bangladeshi artist Ms Rokeya Sultana, in celebration of fifty years of India-Bangladesh relations. Later, this was followed by the musical instruments-making exhibition. The artisans from various parts of the country—Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Rajasthan, Gujarat, Jammu & Kashmir, and Assam—exhibited the making of rare and one-of-a-kind instruments, along with describing their histories and cultural significance. There was also a special performance by Shri Ustad Lalu Khan, a folk singer from Jaisalmer, Rajasthan, as requested by Akademi Secretary Mr Aneish P Rajan and also from the attendees.

After the exhibition, the attention shifted to the Meghdoot Theatre where many exceptional musical talents were showcased. The performances were –

After the events, the students were provided refreshments and a brief informal interaction took place between the performers and the students, following which we were provided with a transport facility by SNA to safely drop us at the college.

The programme was very successful in enlightening the students about the rich musical heritage of India and helping them appreciate the talent of such artists, street performers, trained entertainers and performers.

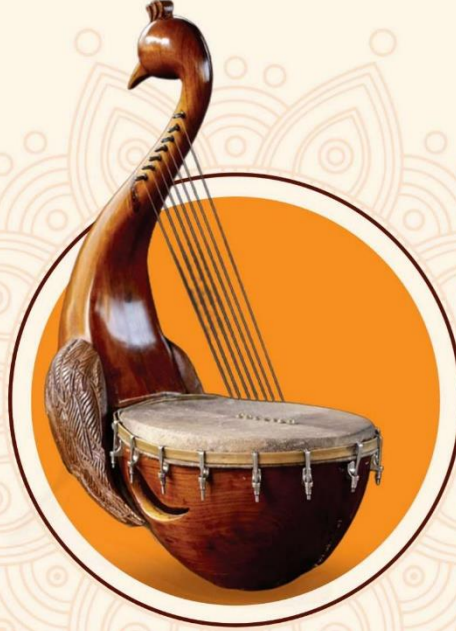
