#### **SUMMARY REPORT**

The workshop on the topic of the Art of Mind Control-A Personality Enrichment Session based on Bhagavad Gita was held on 29<sup>th</sup> November 2022 with **HG Lila Shukh Prabhuji** (Europe) who has been teaching Bhakti Yoga for the past 15 years and **HG Amrit Gaur Prabhuji** (*B.Tech, M.Tech, R&D(AIT), Former Professor, Giani Zail Singh College) from Bhaktivedanta Academy of Culture and Education (BACE)* as the guest speakers. To begin with, the lamp lighting ceremony was performed by the chief guest *HG Lila Shukh Prabhuji* and *HG Amrit Gaur Prabhuji* followed by Mr Krishna Kumar, Department of Economics, Dr Hari Singh, Department of Electronics and Student Volunteers, Department of Electronics. After that, the Guest Speakers were felicitated by offering Tulsi Saplings.

The workshop was initiated by HG Lila Shukh Prabhuji who addressed the gathering and highlighted all the facts regarding philosophy, how their philosophy views other religions, the values of the Holy Bhagavad Gita, how we can encourage and inspire others to read Bhagavad Gita. 


