#### **About Green Humour**

Written and drawn by Rohan Chakravarty, Green Humour is a series of cartoons, comics and illustrations on wild animals; wildlife and nature conservation, environment, sustainability and all things green. With over 300 cartoons and counting, Green Humour is possibly the largest collection of cartoons on wildlife and environment on the web. Cartoons and illustrations from Green Humour have appeared in Sanctuary Asia, Saevus, Current Conservation, Sustainuance, Tigerlink, Tinkle Digest, National Geographic Traveller, the Biodiversity Expeditions magazine and The Hindu Business Line among others; and debuted on the international comics platform 'Gocomics' in December 2013, making it the first series of cartoons and comic strips from India to be distributed internationally. Art from Green Humour has been used for several conservation campaigns and publications by organizations such as WWF, Heart of Borneo, The Wildlife Trust of India, the Nature Conservation Foundation, BNHS, The Humane Society International, The Arunachal Pradesh State Forest Department, The Karnataka State Forest Department, Birdlife International, and the International Crane Foundation. The cartoonist has been the winner of 'Cartoon Contest on Climate Change- A People's Perspective' organized by the UNDP and the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs in February 2012, the Sanctuary Asia Young Naturalist Award in November 2012, the WWF International President's Award in May 2017, and the Royal Bank of Scotland 'Earth Heroes' Award in October 2017.

About the cartoonist- Notorious for rolling up into a ball like a pangolin to avoid answering the phone or meeting people, Rohan is a cartoonist, illustrator and animation designer hailing from Nagpur, the 'Tiger Capital of the World'. A memorable encounter with a beautiful tigress bathing in a Nagzira Wildlife Sanctuary waterhole led him to give up a career in dentistry and take up drawing for wildlife and conservation.
