The history Department annual seminar was organized on 31st January 2017. The teacher-in charge of History Department was Mr. M. Jeevan and the History Society Association In-charge was Ms. Nuti Namita.

On 31st January at 10.30 a.m. Mr. Ratish Nanda delivered the annual lecture. Mr. Nanda is a renowned conservationist, architect and Project Director of the Aga Khan Trust for Culture, India. The topic was 'Conservation of Monuments: A Case Study of Humayun's Tomb'. Mr. Nanda spoke about the significance and need of conservation of historical monuments. He emphasised the importance of making historical spaces available and easily accessible to people, in addition to the need for involving local communities in the conservation activities. The local craftsmen and artisans should be given an opportunity in the renovation work owing to their expertise in traditional art forms. In addition he spoke about the need for conservation efforts to be partaken as partnerships between governmental and private bodies , with the crucial involvement of local communities. The talk, with the help of the case of Humayun's Tomb, lent perspective on the conservation of monuments and the processes, challenges involved therein.
