Lokesh Jain has played a lead role in the film, a feature film on old Delhi, which is making rounds in film festivals globally, 'Ghode ko Jalebi Khilane Le Ja Riya Hoon', directed by Anamika Haksar. The speaker prides himself in being thinking, reflective and expressive inhabitants of Old Delhi soaked in the culture of the walled city who have brought the past glory and present verve alive through their artistic expressions in theater, screenplay writing and activism for over three decades.


