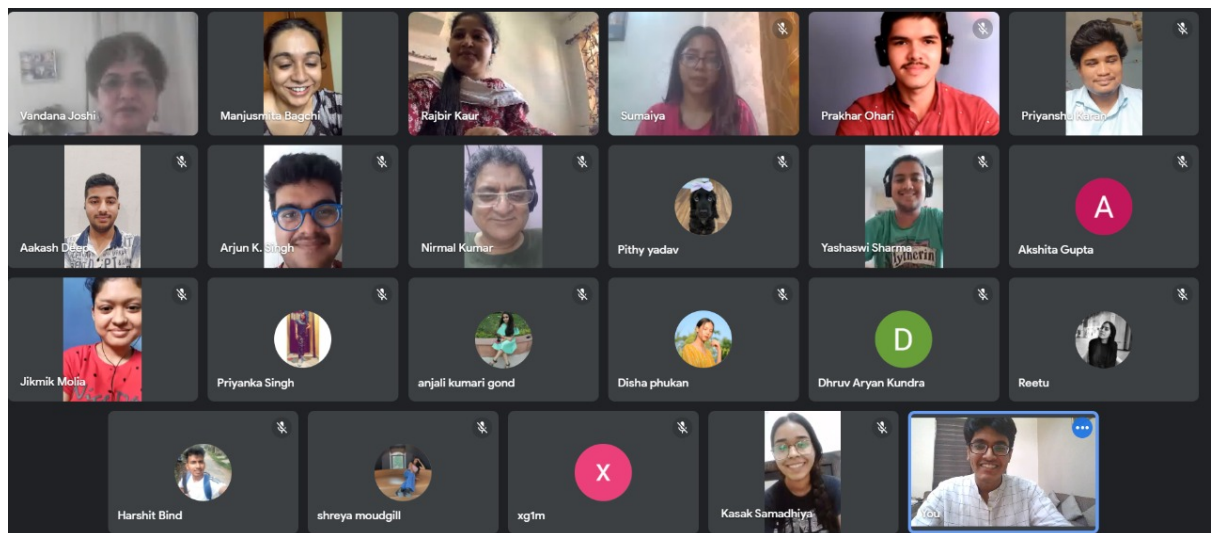
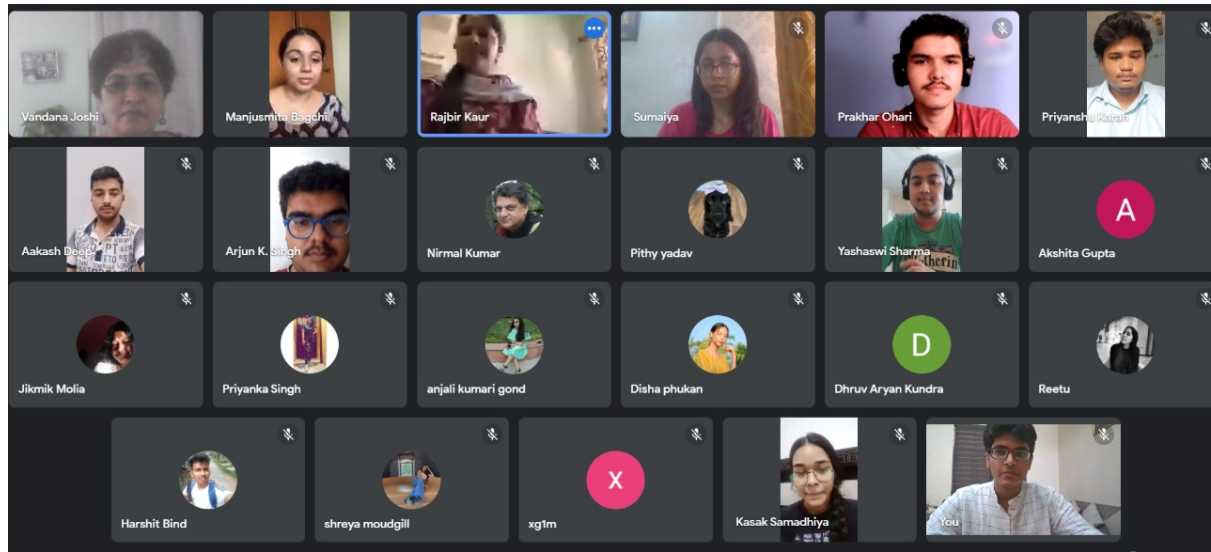


MANJUSMITA BAGCHI
