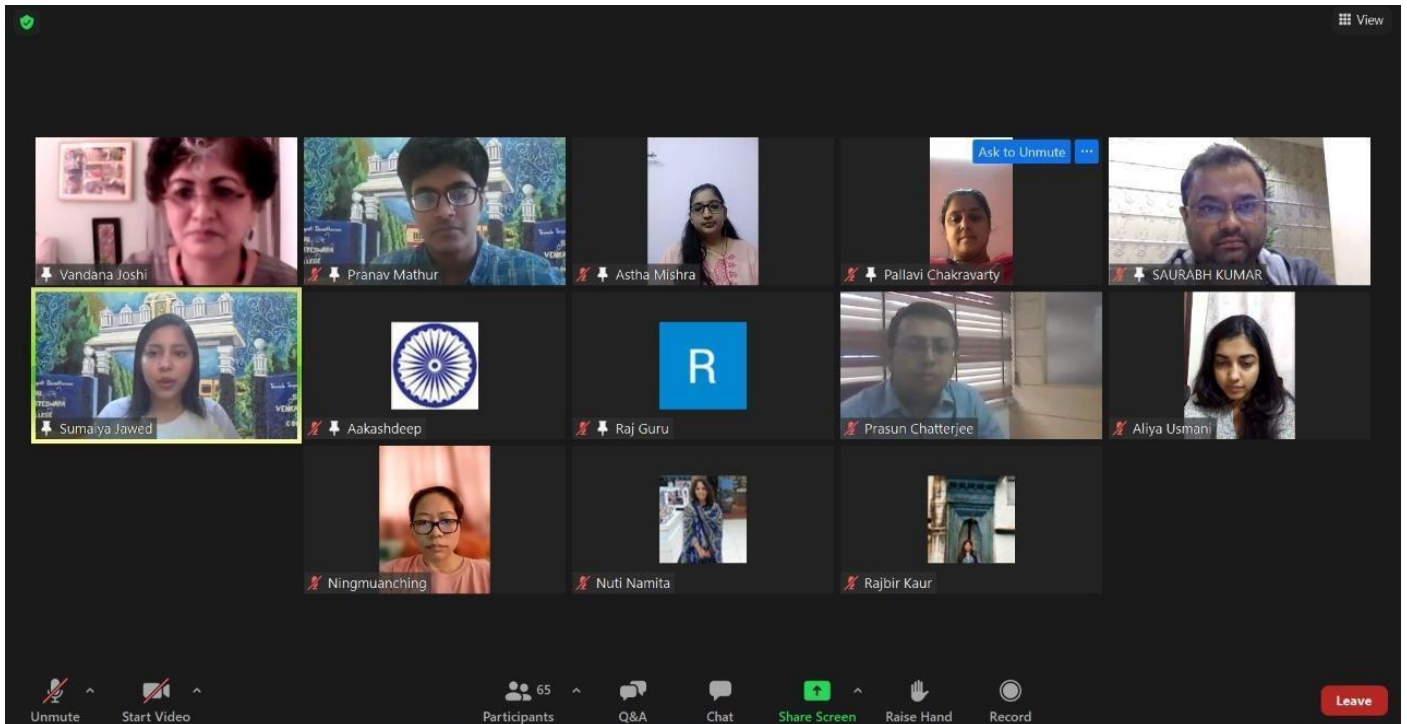
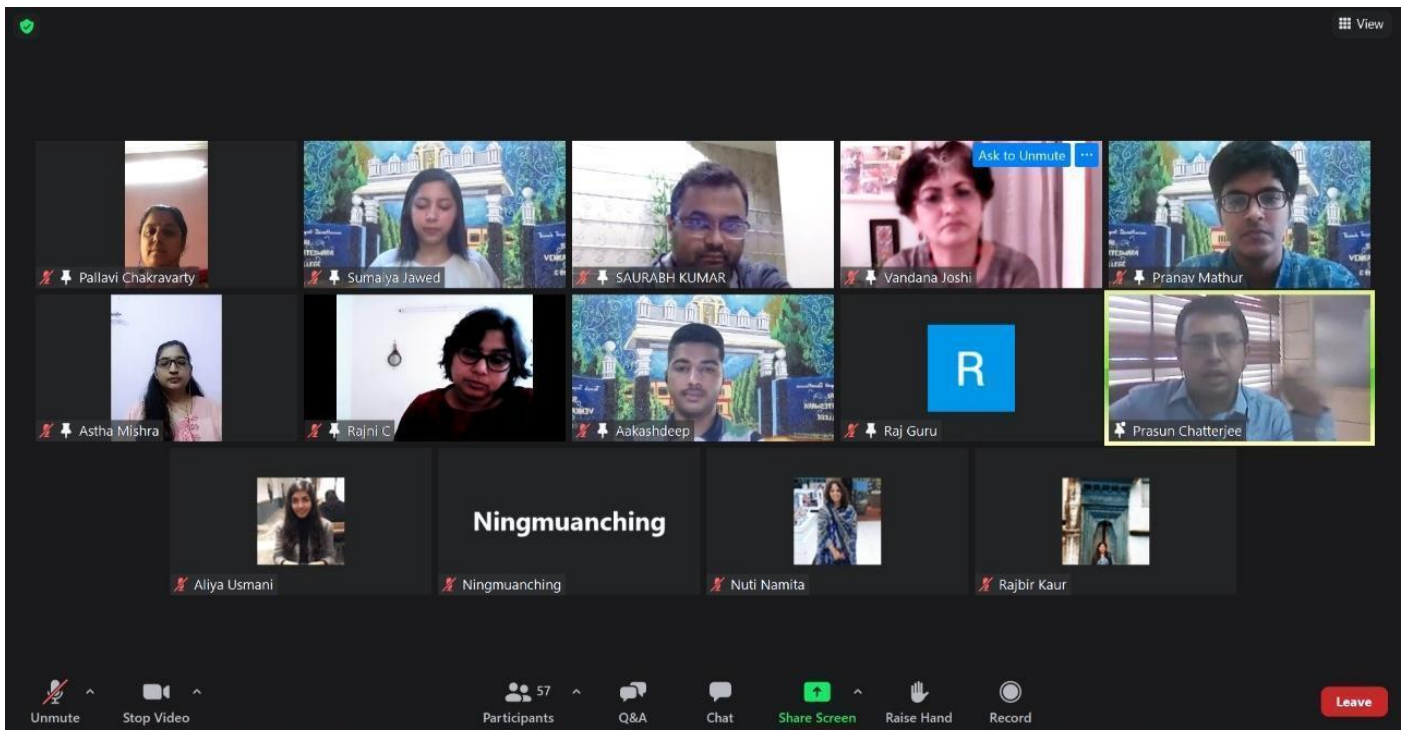

He was awarded his doctorate degree in 2006 from Lucknow University for his thesis on the 'Travels and Descriptions of India by Niccolao Manucci'. He has been associated with the publishing industry for the last fifteen years and worked at Oxford University Press for more than a decade apart from Pearson and Pan Macmillan India. He has steered editorial teams at these places over the years and is currently deputy head of the publishing programme at Primus Books. He has been teaching historical methodology and academic writing to PhD students as a visiting faculty at the department of Dharma Studies, Somaiya Vidyavihar, Mumbai.
