## BRIEF INFORMATION ABOUT THE ACTIVITY

TOPIC/SUBJECT OF THE ACTIVITY	INTERNATIONAL ONLINE SYMPOSIUM by the History Department titled, "Modern India in German Archives: Digital Archiving and New Directions in Research"
OBJECTIVES	To educate students on the importance of archives in pursuing history as a discipline through the example of MIDA  To explore Indo-German relations through a series of shared experiences and recorded historiography.
METHODOLOGY	The two hour long session was held on MS Teams. Three speakers situated in Germany were invited to share their insight on the importance of archives in documenting Indian history. This was elaborated on through the programme MIDA, or Modern India through German Archives. 

## d. Pithy Yadav, 2nd Year,


