
TOPIC/SUBJECT OF THE ACTIVITY	Study Visit to the National Archives of India
OBJECTIVES	The objective of this trip is to sensitize history students regarding the functioning of the Archives, its significance as a repository of the collective memory of the nation and the important collections of the documents stored in the National Archives of India. Another objective is to expose students to various aspects of pursuing a career related to archival and research work which involve consultation of archival sources.
METHODOLOGY	Guided tour of the archive and viewing of the exhibition, followed by hands-on experience of the lamination process involved in the preservation of records, interactive session with the Deputy Director of the Archives.

A visit to National Archives

On 28th October, 2022 students from 2nd and 3rd year of History department of Sri Venkateswara College visited the National Archives for their ongoing exhibition 'Saga of Freedom: Known and Lesser Known Struggles'. The exhibition was organised by the National Archives of India as a part of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav which was opened for public viewing till 30th October. The exhibition was inaugurated by the Union minister of state for culture and parliamentary affairs Anurag Singh Khurana on 12th August, 2022.

The exhibition as it is named 'Saga of Freedom Known and Lesser known struggles' traces the history of India's struggle for independence through various rebellions that occurred in different parts of India which later led to India's independence. These including the Chuar uprising which involved native tribesmen from Bankura and Midnapore districts, Munda revolt of 1894, The Delhi-Lahore conspiracy (1912) also known as the Delhi conspiracy case, The Kirti Kisan movement (1927) in Punjab, The Kakori conspiracy case, Non cooperation movement by Mahatma Gandhi and the Quit India movement as well as some other pivotal movements that occurred in between.

The exhibition displayed authentic government data, maps, newspapers, private papers, modern images and not only that it had a copy of pages from Bhagat Singh's diary which fascinated the students most. Moreover students were delighted to see the unique lamination process of these important documents at the Archives.

The Curatorial walk was followed by an interactive session with Dr. Sanjay Garg, deputy director of Archives who spoke to the students about the various functions of the Archive. He also gave a glimpse about the important collections of documents the Archive has. The interactive session was also filled with questions by students who were keen to understand the various aspects of pursuing archival studies in future.






