

## A visit to National Atchives

On 28th october, 2022 students from 2nd and 3rd year of History department of Sri venkateswara College visited the National Anchives for their Ongoing exhibition 'Saga of Freedom's known and Lesser known struggles'. The exhibition was organised by the National Anchones of India as a part of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav which was opened for public viewing till 30th October. The exhibition was inaugurated by the Union minister of State for culture and parliamentary affairs Aryun Ram Neghwal on 12th August, 2022.

The exhibition as it is named 'saga of freedom known and lesser known struggles' treates the history of India's struggle for independence through various rebellions that occurred in different parts of India which later led to India's independence.

These including the Chuar uprising which involved native tribes men from Bankura and Midnaporce districts, munda revolt of 1894, The Delhi-lahorce conspiracy (1912) also known as the belli conspiracy case, the kirti kisan movement (1927) in punjab,

The kakorci conspiracy case, kon cooperation movement by Mahatma Gandhi and the Quit India movement as used as some other pivotal movements that

The exhibition displayed authentic government data, maps, newspapers, private papers, modern images and not only that it had a copy of pages from Bhagat Singh's diarry which fascinated the students most. Moreover students neare delighted to see the unique lanination process of these important documents at the Anchives.

The curatorial walk was followed by an interactive session with Dr. Sanjay lyang, deputy director of Archives who spoke to the students about the various functions of the Archive. He also gave a glimpse about the important collections of documents the Archive has. The interactive session was also filled with questions by students who were keen to understand the various aspects of pursuing archival studies in future.
