



The Department of History, Sri Venkateswara College successfully organized its annual department fest - Legacy on 17th February, 2023. This year's theme for the annual fest was 'Jashn-e-Hindustan : An Indian Cultural Symphony '.Continuing with the idea of starting the day with the Dr. Neeraj Sahay Memorial lecture, this year Dr. Najaf Haider was invited to deliver his lecture on 'The Monetary Economy of India in the Eighteenth Century '. Dr. Haider, a very experienced professor of Medieval and Early Modern History at the Centre for Historical Studies, JNU elaborated upon many important points in his lecture. He highlighted how there were different existing mediums and materials used in the trade. There was a maintained list showing the shifts in the prices of different commodities which was visible in the texts of the economic department of medieval Mughal administration as highlighted by Professor.

It was an interesting lecture followed by an elaborate Q/A session with the students and faculty. This was followed by different events organized by the department attracting huge participation from different colleges of the Delhi University circuit. Justujoo- an India quiz competition witnessed a special attraction from the quizzers across the college and university and at the end three teams secured top three positions in the final round.

Rang-e-Bahara : a poster making competition was conducted on the theme Cultural Tourism through India. Participants were given different Indian states and the final works showing their creativity was worth seeing. A treasure hunt 'Khoj-e-Khazana' was also organized where participants were divided into teams comprising 3-4 members. Team from Miranda House won the competition.With this an online photography competition 'Nazara-e-Dilli' was organized where participants exhibited their capture of this beautiful city's architectural diversity.
