New Delhi, 20 January 2023. The Indian National Trust for Art and Cultural Heritage (INTACH), a charitable non-profit organisation which holds consultative status with United Nations Economic and Social Council organised a seminar and heritage walk programme where the students of the History Department of Sri Venkateswara College participated.

Delhi is famous for its chilly winters. Amidst this cold, INTACH's workshop came like a warm ray of hope for the students of SVC. It has been the ethos of Sri Venkateswara College to appreciate and protect the legacy

of Indian culture and tradition. It is with this spirit our students began the session. At 9 am, the session commenced with a fabulously informative presentation on the history of Delhi by Ms Swapna Liddle. This presentation was followed by another by Mr Amit Kumar on the heritage conservation efforts of INTACH, which enthralled the students. Dr Randhawa ended the seminar with a presentation on vernacular
