- The ICSSR has sanctioned a grant-in-aid of Rs.23,40,000/- (Rupees Twenty three lakhs forty thousand only) for the above research project and the grant will be released as follows:

First instalment@40% :Rs. 9,36,000
Second instalment@30% :Rs. 7,02,000
Third instalment@20% :Rs. 4,68,000
Final Instalment@5% :Rs. 1,17,000/Publication cost*@5% :Rs. 23,40,000/Total :Rs. 2000/** :whichever is lesser.

Overhead charges @ 5% or Rs.1,17,000/-** whichever is lesser.

- * ICSSR would publish it subject to recommendation by the expert and relevant Committees for the purpose, from the overall budget, so to be retained by the ICSSR.

- 4. The First installment of the approved grant-in-aid @25% of Rs 5,85,00,066/- is already released to you. Remaining grant of 15% of the approved grant as arrears will be released after receiving grant-in-aid bill duly filled in, stamped and signed by the Project Director as well as the affiliating organization.
- In case, the study involves survey research, the finalized schedules/questionnaires (2 copies)
 designed to elicit information should be sent to the ICSSR as per the following schedule:

- 6. The Second instalment of 30% grant will be released after receiving a satisfactory and simple statement of account of the first instalment, Research Papers (one to two) along with minutes of the Advisory Committee meeting duly signed by the members of the Advisory Committee.
- 7. Third instalment 20% will be released after receiving the Final Report (two hard copies and one soft copy either CD/pen-drive) along with the executive summary (3000 to 4000 words/ten copies) and information relating to the research project as may be asked for by the ICSSR for preservation in its
- 8. The scholar should acknowledge support of ICSSR that the project has been sponsored by the ICSSR, in all publications resulting from the project output (Research Paper, Books, Articles, Reports, etc.) and submit a copy of the same to the ICSSR during its course and after completion.
- 9. The final instalment will be released on the receipt of: (a) Satisfactory book length of the Final Report in the publishable form after incorporating all corrections, suggestions of the expert; (b) Statement of accounts and Utilization Certificate in GFR of 19A format for the entire project amount duly signed by the affiliating institution (c) A certificate of statement of assets and books purchased out of the project fund issued by the affiliating institution.
- 10. The University/Institution of affiliation will provide to the scholar office accommodation including furniture, library and research facilities and messengerial services. For this, the ICSSR shall pay to the whichever is lesser, incurred on the project only after successful completion of the project.
- 11. The Contingency Grant may be utilized for research and office assistance, books, stationary, computer cost, research assistance and the field work expenses of Project Director, Co-Project Directors and research personnel connected with the research work.
- 12. The accounts and the Utilization Certificate will be signed by the Finance Officer/Registrar/ Director in the case of accounts of the institution are audited by CAG/AG. Otherwise, they need to be signed by the Finance Officer and the Chartered Account.
- 13. The Director of the research project will be Dr. Varadraj Bapat, who will be responsible for its completion within 15 Months from the date of commencement of the project, which is 15/05/2018,
- 14. In case, the Project Director does not submit the periodic / final project report as per schedule with adequate justification, the scholar may be debarred from availing all future financial assistance from ICSSR.
