



This photography competition provided the students a platform to express numerous forces of cognitive processes through the artistic and expressive medium of photography.

The theme which was selected for the competition was "Indian Pluralities and Freedom of Expression". A google form was circulated for the participants to register and submit their entries.

Rules and regulations of the competition were as follows:

- 1) This is an individual event. Team participation is not allowed.
- 2) Only 1 photograph can be submitted by each participant.
- 3) Photographs should be renamed in the format "Theme Your FullName (Eg-Indian Pluralities SameerSingh)"
- 4) Mobile photography is allowed.
- 5) Photographs must be the original work of the participant.
- 6) Plagiarism will lead to disqualification.
- 7) Photographs must be of High resolution. They should have proper EXIF data.
- 8) Watermarks are not allowed.
- 9) Basic editing in the form of cropping, sharpness, etc. is permitted. Manipulation is not allowed.
- 10) Size of the image should not be more than 10MB.

- 11) The decision of the judges will be final and binding.
- 12) The competition is open to all undergraduates across the country.

The total number of people who participated in the event was 12. The criteria for entries were that they are accurate, fair, and capture the theme. The platform used for the event was the Department mail id. No registration fee was charged.

The deadline for registration was 11th April 2022 and the results were declared on 15th April 2022. The entries received were unique and included out-of-the-box thinking. After going through all the entries, the following students were declared the winners:

Second Position: Thale Ram
