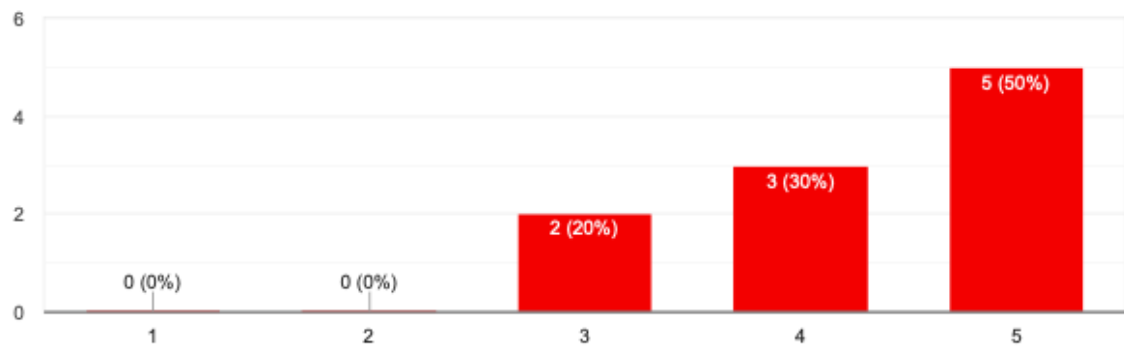

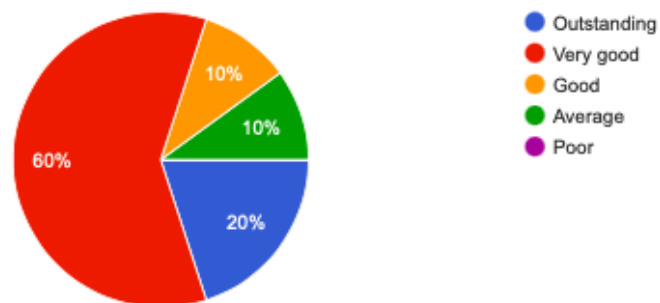

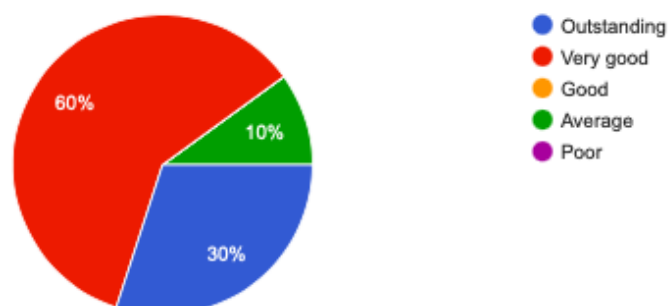

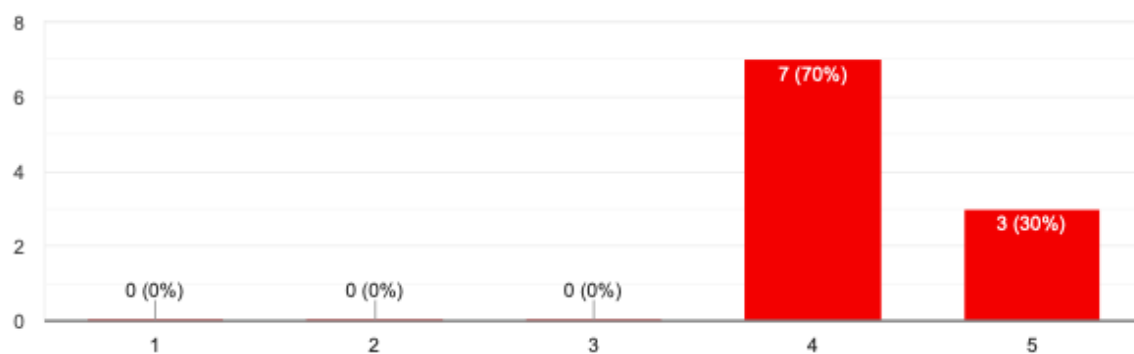

INTROSPECT'22 Workshop on “Academic Writing and Publication”

On 14th April 2022, the Department of Political Science, Sri Venkateswara College organised the Day-2 of Introspect'22 - the annual fest of the department.

The event was hosted by Jayita Pal who commenced the event by inviting Dr. Deepika Singh (faculty member) to address the audience and welcome everyone to Introspect'22. Dr. Deepika Singh welcomed the chief guest for the day Dr. Thongkholal Haokip, Assistant Professor at the Centre for Study of Law and Governance, JNU, New Delhi. His area of specialisation involves governance, democracy, ethnicity and ethnic relations, borderline studies, India's Look East policy and North East India studies.

The workshop began with a discussion on "why academic writing and publication are important for India's future"? Dr. Haokip emphasised the formal writing style which is used in colleges and universities that is term paper used in the academic writing and how it should be clear, concise, focused, structured and backed up with evidence. Its main purpose is to aid the readers' understanding. It must have a formal tone and style and should not be complex and have a complicated vocabulary. Adding more to it, he told that academic writing must be planned and focused, structured, evidenced and should be formal in tone and style. Then taking the example of the National Education Policy 2020, he talked about the reduction in the curriculum which would involve core essentials, critical thinking which focuses on inquiry, discovery, discussion and analysis based on teaching and learning methods for holistic education. He also talked about transforming the curricular and pedagogical structure and distinguished between the existing academy structure and the new academic structure. Moving on, sir mentioned the importance, determinants, language, organization of paper, title, abstract, keywords, the importance of a good title, methodology, discussions, writing a good introduction and references, footnotes and endnotes of a quality paper.

The illuminating session came to an end after he welcomed questions from the audience which led to a fruitful and knowledgeable Q/A session. Finally, the event was concluded with a formal vote of thanks delivered by Diviniti Kothari

(event executive) who thanked the speaker, faculty members, event coordinators and the audience for making the event a huge success.
