On 27 February 2023, the Second-Year students of the Department of Political Science, Sri Venkateswara College got the opportunity to visit the Parliament House, accompanied by Dr. Haokam Vaiphei for an insightful trip about the legislative process of the nation. Being the highest forum for discussion and democracy, the Parliament House, despite not being in session, held a grandeur unlike any other, and was immensely intriguing for the students of the department

The visit was facilitated by Ms. [name, designation], who took the students around the building, providing valuable insights into the colonial legacy of the architecture, as well as intricate details about the working of the House. Sitting in the Lok Sabha and the Rajya Sabha, the students were given first-hand knowledge about the physical demarcations in the Houses, their significance, as well as how they translate into the legislative proceedings.

The students posed various questions in relation to the budget session in the Parliament, the role of standing committees and so on. The group then proceeded to visit the Central Hall in the Parliament, where the joint sittings of Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha take place, and also interestingly the very hall where the Constitution was signed. Another round of Q and A ultimately culminated in the students visiting the statue of Mahatma Gandhi outside the Parliament House.

The Department of Political Science is extremely grateful to Mr. Shominthang Haokip, Security Assistant, Rajya Sabha, for helping in organise the visit and Ms. Jubilee Hmar, Security Assistant for guiding us on the tour and providing them with information that deepened their understanding of democracy as well as the legislature of the country.
