

polscience.svc *Major highlights:* •The religion and religious beliefs is the key identity of the Islamic states. •Unlike other organisations, in case of ISIS, their ideology predates the establishment of the organised community of first jihadis and now terrorists. It was on the basis of this religious doctrine that IS was able to brainwash the minds of thousands of innocents individual professionals, non-professionals, skilled force, unskilled force - and has expanded itself to half of the world, increasing its sphere much larger than the Al-Qaida. •The former ISIS caliph, Abu bakr Al - Baghdadi, was a member of Quraysh tribal grouping, from which it is assumed that Prophet Muhammad also originated. •Islamic states is a representative of Sunni Islam. •Each act of IS, from sexual slavery of yazhidi women to burning alive of American pilots, was justified on the basis of Islamic principles to curb the predicaments of the society. • Islamic states is also linked to Saudi wahabi doctrine. •The Islamic state believes that "the end of days" is near and are thus, preparing for a final battle to be held between good and evil, which according to the organisation, will take place in Syria. Viewing IS as an aberration is extremely problematic given the support their views have. One in every 4 British Muslims believe that a person insulting prophet Muhammad deserves nothing less than death. •Al Jazeera, the news agency, in one of their survey, ask their state population, "do you support the victory of IS in your region?" To this, nearly 81% people voted on yes. They wanted ISIS to

81% people voted on yes. They wanted ISIS to be victorious because they see the terrorists organisation as audacious and willing enough to stand against western supremacy and diplomacy of interference. •Today, IS sleeper cells operate in 60 countries and 17 regional affiliates, from Indonesia to Nigeria. •There are currently 7 civil wars going on in Iraq, Syria, Afghanistan, Libya, Yemen, Somalia, and northern Nigeria - all predominantly Muslim nations. In each of these countries, Islamic states is not just active but rapidly growing and deepening its roots.
