#### **REPORT:**

The Annual Lecture of the Department of Sociology for the academic session 2022-23 took place on 13<sup>th</sup> March 2023. Prof. Roma Chatterji (retd.) Department of Sociology, Delhi School of Economics, University of Delhi delivered this year's annual lecture on 'The Superhero Image and Ravana Mythology'.

Prof Chatterji has researched and written extensively on the sociology of art, narrative theory, folklore, illness narratives, and collective violence. She is the author of Writing Identities: Folklore and Performance in Purulia, West Bengal (2009), Speaking with Pictures: Folk art and the narrative tradition in India (2012), and co-author of Living with Violence: An Anthropology of Events and Everyday Life (2007). She is also the editor of Wording the World: Veena Das and Scenes of Inheritance (2015). Her most recent publication titled Graphic Narratives and the Mythological Imagination in India (2020), explores graphic narratives and comics in India to demonstrate how these forms serve as sites on which myths are enacted and recast.

The event commenced with felicitating Prof. Chatterji, followed by her lecture. Exploring the relationship between narratives and visual images, the speaker discussed how the images in superhero comics contribute in significant ways to construct the narrative. She elaborated how pictorial technique, page layout style along with vanishing-point perspective are all used to imply movement of the characters and scenes of action. Building on her argument through a detailed analysis of the mini-series *Ravanayan* published by Holy Cow Entertainment, Prof. Chatterji's lecture thus involved a critical reading of the myth as represented in the comic book, appealing to the sensibility of mature comic book readers. Her talk allowed students to be introduced to concepts of perspective, movement, pictorial techniques and page layout in visual comic texts, and their connection to the construction of representations of masculinity and violence in the narratives underlying them.


