She currently teaches at the Department of Political Science, Indraprastha College for Women, University of Delhi where she has also been involved with activities of the Gandhi Study Circle. She spent a semester at Tel Aviv University, Tel Aviv, Israel studying the writings and exchanges between Martin Buber and MK Gandhi. She has published and lectured on Gandhi and is one of the finest of contemporary Gandhi scholars.

**Hari Nair** studied History at Loyola College, Chennai, JNU and UNAM, Mexico. His doctoral work at the National Autonomous University of Mexico (UNAM) was on the Native Americans of Mesoamerica during the early phase of the Spanish conquest. His research interests include Gandhi studies, history of political thought, and many more. He has published extensively, and is currently studying the trajectory of the struggles of suppressed races in the modern period. He teaches at the Department of Humanities and Social Sciences, BITS, Pilani.
