
7.1.7 The Institution has disabled-friendly, barrier free environment Inclusion and Situatedness

The EOC has members from teaching staff as well as students and volunteers. The EOC takes care of specific requirements of the differently abled students of the college, and takes up their issues such as providing physical facilities and logistic support. The volunteers of EOC help the differently abled students in work related to their examinations, admit cards etc.






Wheelchair ramp






Disabled-friendly washrooms






Disabled-friendly washroom
