REPORT

Sri Venkateswara College celebrated the completion of Diamond Jubilee with great pomp and show on 28th August, 2022 in the college grounds. The Valedictory Function witnessed the presence of luminaries of education who apprised the people at the helm of affairs (teachers, staffs and students) about how the National Education Policy 2020 is aimed at equipping the future of the nation for nation building and development.

The Chief Guest of the session was Shri Dharmendra Pradhan, Honourable Minister of Education, Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, Govt. of India. Shri Y. V. Subba Reddy, Chairman, T.T.D Trust Board and College Governing Body presided over the function. Prof. Yogesh Singh, Vice Chancellor, University of Delhi and Prof. M. Jagadesh Kumar, Chairman, UGC were the Guest of Honour. Other special guests were Prof. Shri Prakash Singh, Director, University of Delhi, South Campus, Prof. Balram Pani, Dean of Colleges, University of Delhi, Prof. Randeep Guleria, Padma Shri awardee, Director, AIIMS, New Delhi, Ms. Nalini Asthana & Ms. Kamalini Asthana, Padma Shri Awardee & renowned Kathak Duo. The celebration began with the lamp lighting ceremony, wherein all the dignitaries lighted the auspicious lamp and invoked the blessings of lord Balaji.

Prof. C. Sheela Reddy, Principal, Sri Venkateswara College, delivered the welcome address and opening remarks. She began by stressing that the yearlong Diamond Jubilee celebrations of Sri Venkateswara College reverberate with the University's centennial celebrations and our country's Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav. She reminded how the spirited vision of three luminaries, Smt. Durgabai Deshmukh, Sri K.L.Rao and Sri C. Anna Rao to establish an undergraduate college in the national capital by Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams was realised in August 1961, with the laying of foundation stone, in the present campus by Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan, the then Vice-president of India, an eminent teacher, a great philosopher and a statesman.

She highlighted that in the year 1961, the college started off with 271 students and 13 faculty, Sri Venkateswara College has grown from strength to strength. Currently, with the support of 211 teachers and 151 non-teaching staff, the college offers 20 Undergraduate courses in sciences, humanities and commerce; one PG Diploma course and 9 post graduate programs serving the educational needs of more than 4000 students from all over India. The college consistently features in the top ten to fifteen best colleges in India in various government and non-government rankings such as MHRD-NIRF, India Today, Outlook and the Week.

During the Diamond Jubilee year, the college underwent the second cycle of NAAC accreditation in April 2022 and was awarded A+ grade. This marks an improvement from 'A' Grade that was received in the first cycle of NAAC in 2016.

Like all higher educational institutions, the college is trying to build upon some of the key features of New Education Policy 2020 (NEP) such as Multidisciplinarity, innovative pedagogy, experiential learning and emphasis on Indian languages.

At Sri Venkateswara College, Indian language courses on Tamil, Telugu and Sanskrit certificate courses in Foreign Languages like Spanish, German and French foster a multilingual environment, while several add-on courses like Ayurbiology, Intellectual property rights, Entrepreunership, Digital marketing, Climate change, and Indian Music & Culture enrich the students' learning experience.

'Education is not the learning of facts but training of minds to think'. To encourage multidisciplinary research at undergraduate level a notable initiative (SRI-VIPRA) i.e., Sri Venkateswara Internship Program for Research and Academics was started by IQAC in 2019. This summer internship programme aims to instill research bent of mind in students.

To encourage interdisciplinary collaborations among faculty in Sri Venkateswara College, a Research Conclave was organized for the first time during the Diamond Jubilee year. A compilation of the research interests of faculty has been consolidated in the research magazine 'Venquest'.

Many Faculty have been awarded research grants by several government and non-government organizations including University Grants Commission, University of Delhi, Dept of Science and Technology (DST),

Department of Biotechnology, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Indraprastha Gas Limited and several others.

In an everchanging and dynamic world, the frontiers of exchange and collaborations are imperative. Sri Venkateswara College lays great emphasis in establishing and fostering linkages with other institutions of eminence. The college has long standing MoUs with All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi and Nordic Centre in India.

During the Diamond Jubilee year, new MoUs with Czech University of Life Sciences Prague, National University of Uzbekistan, National Institute of Immunology, Delhi, National Productivity Council, Ministry of Commerce and Industry, and K. J. Somaiya College of Science and Commerce, Mumbai to name a few. These MoUs aim to promote academic exchanges, enhance the research capabilities and strengthen capacity building of students and faculty.

To facilitate academic growth, the college is committed to providing the best infrastructural facilities to its fraternity. Although we had to defer some development activities on account of the pandemic, we took the opportunity to refurbish many parts of the college building, canteen, and laboratories, in the diamond jubilee year. With financial support from T.T.D, our state-of-the art Sports facilities saw addition of synthetic Tennis courts & Basketball courts. On their successful completion, our beloved Chairman, Sri Y. V. Subba Reddy Garu inaugurated these facilities in April, 2022. Soon, we will also see a newly constructed boundary wall, a fully renovated automated library, and we will take up the long pending project of completion of auditorium with the kind support of TTD.

During the Diamond Jubilee year, the college undertook many environmental initiatives aimed at sustainability. Our efforts towards water, waste and energy management as well as sanitation and hygiene and green campus have been well appreciated.

We have been recognized as Swachhta Action Plan Institution by Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education (MGNCRE), Dept of Higher Education, Ministry of Education. Around 40% of the college campus is under green cover with a well-documented, QR-coded collection of native trees with demarcated areas for wild space, garden, herbarium and nursery. We were awarded a certificate of recognition as Sustainable Campus by MGNCRE, Ministry of Education in April 2022.

During the Diamond Jubilee Year, we installed a 140kW on-grid solar power plant under the zero-investment RESCO model. With partial funding from Indraprastha Gas Limited, we undertook the construction of rainwater harvesting structures to facilitate ground water recharge, and received the successful completion certificate from Delhi Jal Board. A booklet titled 'Green Campus' documents these environmental initiatives, aerial images of lush green cover and avian biodiversity on campus. This is a small endeavour to raise environmental consciousness about the importance of nurturing and preserving our green heritage.

Value-based education is at the core of the social fabric of Sri Venkateswara College. Regular outreach and extension programs by college societies such as National Service Scheme, Women Development Cell, Enactus, Fine Arts association, Eco Club, Equal Opportunity Cell provide students an opportunity to understand complex societal challenges and shoulder responsibilities to be agents of social change. SVC recently adopted two colleges in Ladakh to share knowledge and expertise under the 'DU Vidya Vistaar' initiative. A project undertaken by faculty with funding from National Mission on Himalayan Studies, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate change contributed in preservation of hill ecology, reviving tourism and creating employment opportunities in the Almora district of Uttarakhand.

Sri Venkateswara College takes pride in the achievements of its students who brought numerous accolades and laurels in academics, sports, co-curricular and extracurricular activities, bringing name and fame to the college. I thank all the faculty, non-teaching staff, and students whose commitment and dedication has made Sri Venkateswara College an institution of repute in the academic milieu.

She humbly acknowledged the support from University Grants Commission in the academic growth and progress of the college since its inception. As a constituent college of University of Delhi, she expressed her gratitude to the University for facilitating the day-to-day smooth functioning as well as support rendered in admission process, conduct of examinations, design of curriculum and in all administrative and policy matters, including recruitment of teaching and non-teaching staff.

With the generous support of the management of the Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams (TTD) Trust and the Government of Andhra Pradesh under the youthful leadership of Sri Y. S. Jagan Mohan Reddy, Hon'ble CM and with timely guidance from University of Delhi, the College has carved a niche for itself as a prominent,

Pathnam meaning studying, mananam meaning remembering, chintanam meaning critically thinking and sankeertanam meaning repeating the whole process. The role of a guru is to create an ecosysytem of learners who can critically think and be a life long learner. He encouraged all the teachers to become gurus.

He narrated a story in which a cat saw a small mouse on left side and found another healthy mouse on its right side. The cat had to decide which mouse to eat, the cat decided to hunt the smaller mouse. When the

cat hunted it, it found no flesh, no blood. The moral of the story is never go for low hanging fruits, you should always set your goal very high as that is when you can achieve something big and great. He ended the speech with wishing a great future to the college.
