METHODOLOGY	 The proposal was given by Dr. Rajesh Singh, University Librarian, University of Delhi. The proposal was approved by the Vice Chancellor Prof. Yogesh Singh. Prof. Yogesh Singh, Vice Chancellor, University of Delhi Launched Centenary E-Book Collections and Digital Archives on 6th June, 2023 at 10:30 A.M., Conference Centre. The Honorable VC sanctioned 27 crores for the procurement of E-books and E-journals. DULS procured more than 84,000 E-books and other resources from 10 major publishers worldwide. The first session was the inaugural session and the guest for the same was Prof. Yogesh Singh, Vice Chancellor, University of Delhi; Dr. Vikas Gupta, Registrar, University of Delhi; Dr. Rajesh Singh, University Librarian, University of Delhi; Prof Rajeev Gupta, CEO of Institution of Eminence and Prof. Neeta Sehgal, Chairperson of E-resources Committee. The first session began with the University of Delhi "Kulgeet". After that Chief Guest lighted the diyas. Dr. Rajesh Singh warmly welcomed all invited guests and presented them with shawl and plant saplings. The Honorable VC launched the E-Book Collections and Digital Archives for all. The session demonstrated every steps involving searching/downloading of E-books and E-journals from DU e-library app and its website to the library professionals, students and faculty members. REPORT ON LAUNCH OF CENTENARY E-BOOK COLLECTIONS AND DIGITAL ARCHIVES ORGANIZED BY DELHI UNIVERSITY LIBRARY SYSTEM ON 6TH JUNE 2023

The launch event of the centenary E-Book Collections and Digital Archieves was organized by the Delhi University Library System (DULS) on June 6th, 2023. The inaugural session was graced by esteemed personalities and guests including **Prof. Yogesh Singh, Vice Chancellor, University of Delhi; Dr. Vikas Gupta, Registrar, University of Delhi; Dr. Rajesh Singh, University Librarian, University of Delhi; Prof Rajeev Gupta, CEO of Institution of Eminence** and **Prof. Neeta Sehgal, Chairperson of E-resources Committee.** The session commenced with the University of Delhi's "Kulgeet" and was followed the lighting the Diyas by the Chief Guest. Dr. Rajesh Singh warmly welcomed all invited guests and presented them with shawl and plant saplings. He provided a brief introduction of the event, after which the Honorable Vice Chancellor officially launched the E-Book Collections and Digital Archives, making them accessible to all students and faculty members. These resources consist of over 84,000 E-books acquired by DULS from 10 major publishers worldwide. These E-Books can be accessed through DULS E-Library app and website. The app is also available on Play Store. The honorable Vice Chancellor sanctioned 27 crores for the procurement of E-books and E-journals for this project.

The second session, which was a training session, commenced after tea break, It aimed familiarised library professionals, students and faculty members about searching/downloading of E-books and E-journals from DU e-library app and its website. The session also provided guidance on how to register in Delhi University Library System to access E-Book Collections and Digital Archives. The process of registration is given below

Process of Registration:-

Till now Delhi University Library System gave access to use the DU e-library to the faculty members. Undergraduate students now have the opportunity to access the DU e-library. To facilitate their access, Institutional ID and Passwords need to be created for the students, which will remain valid till the end of the academic session. Faculty members and library staff have already received their ID and Passwords for DU e-library. To generate ID and Passwords for newly joined faculty, staff, and UG/PG students, their details should be sent in an excel format to remoteaccess@duls.du.ac.in or elibrary@duls.du.ac.in. The following information is required for registration:

- 1) Name
- 2) Designation (Faculties/Staff/ Students)
- 3) ID Number/ Roll Number
- 4) Department/ Course
- 5) Institutional email ID
- 6) Contact Number

Once the details are submitted, the DU e-library will send the ID and Passwords directly to the user's email ID within 24 hours. After this process, students and faculty members will have access to the E-books collection and digital archives through the DU e-library. The significant acquisition of over 84,000 E-books from 10 major publishers worldwide presents a valuable opportunity for both students and faculty members.

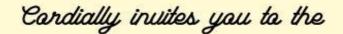

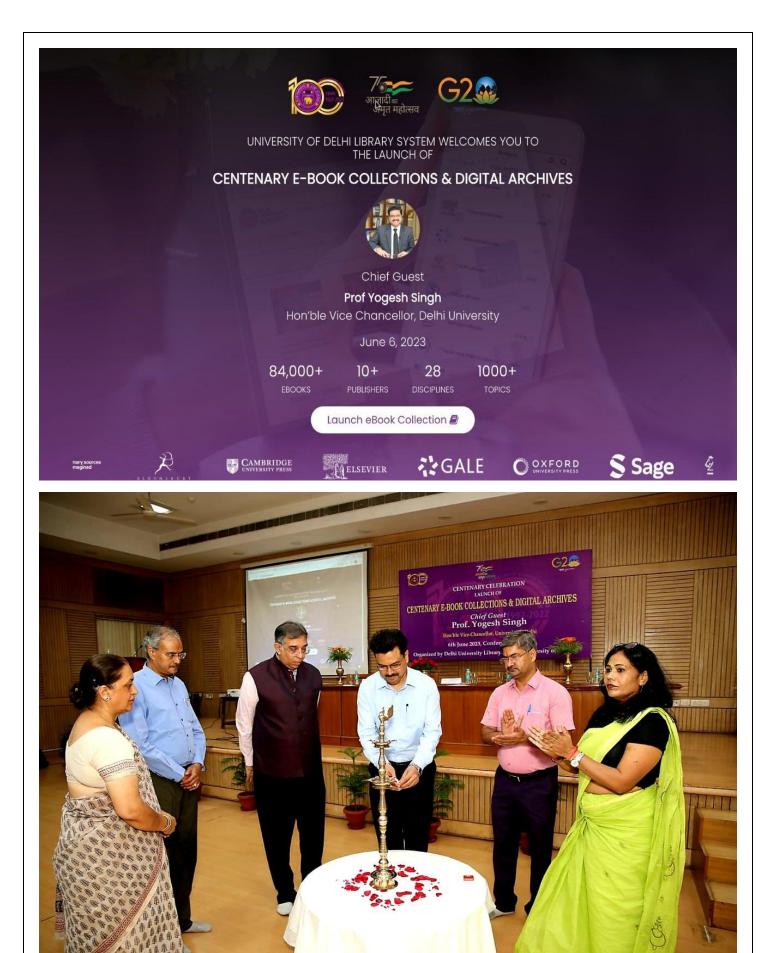

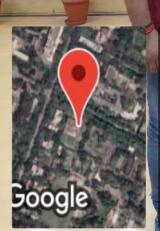
