After the discussions, the parties have agreed to sign MOU on cooperation as follows:

1. Purpose of cooperation

Cooperation to promote the development in the field of human resources training, scientific research and technology transfer between Sri Venkateswara College, University of Delhi, India, and Faculty of Agriculture Ferdowsi University of Mashhad, Iran; to contribute to tighten relations of friendship, and traditions between India and Iran.

2. Field of cooperation

a) The Parties shall endeavor to develop cooperation in the following areas of cooperation:

- Training human resources for basic and applied research in agronomy and environmental sciences and microbiology;
- Sustainable development of agricultural practice in the changing climate situation.
- Cooperating in scientific research and technology transfer in various fields such as Environmental protection, food technology, Forestry and wood processing, biotechnology and renewable energy;

b) The parties support the information exchange, participation in seminars, and conferences.

3. General agreement:

a) This MOU forms basis framework, so that the parties can develop and implement next cooperation programs between them.

- b) This MOU will come into effect from the date of signing, be valid for a period of four (4) years and for a further term by writing agreement between the parties.
- c) The cooperation will be done in accordance with the laws of each country and the capacity of each party. The Parties may agree to add additional areas of cooperation after mutual consultations and supplement them in writing to this Memorandum of Understanding.
- d) In the implementation process if any arise, the Parties will discuss and agree the issue in a spirit of cooperation and the parties will jointly sign the addenda. Any amendment to this MOU shall be effective only if it is fully and legally signed and approved by all parties. The rights and responsibilities recorded in this MOU will continue to be valid for the successors of the parties in it.
- e) Each party shall assign a person as in-charge of coordination for follow-up and developing cooperation in related and agreed upon activity.
