TOPIC/SUBJECT OF THE ACTIVITY	Workshop on International Yoga Day 2021
OBJECTIVES	<p>Yoga is known to have both physical as well as mental benefits. It improves posture, enhances functioning of all the body systems, along with enhancing muscle strength, coordination and flexibility. Yoga affects emotions and helps in calming down the mind, gives mental clarity and a better self-understanding. Yoga is highly recommended for people in competitive, stressful working environments. In today's scenario, practising yoga on a regular basis becomes all the more crucial not just for evading the number of diseases the pandemic has surfaced but also as a tool for self healing and to avoid stress and anxiety, given the conditions which fail to give a peace of mind to the general public. Thus the objectives of the activity were to encourage the audience to perform yoga regularly in order to have a calm mind and getting/maintaining their body into shape.</p>
METHODOLOGY	<p>The theme for International Yoga Day 2021, by the United Nations, was "Yoga for well-being". A poster was designed and released for registration for the workshop and an overwhelming response was received. 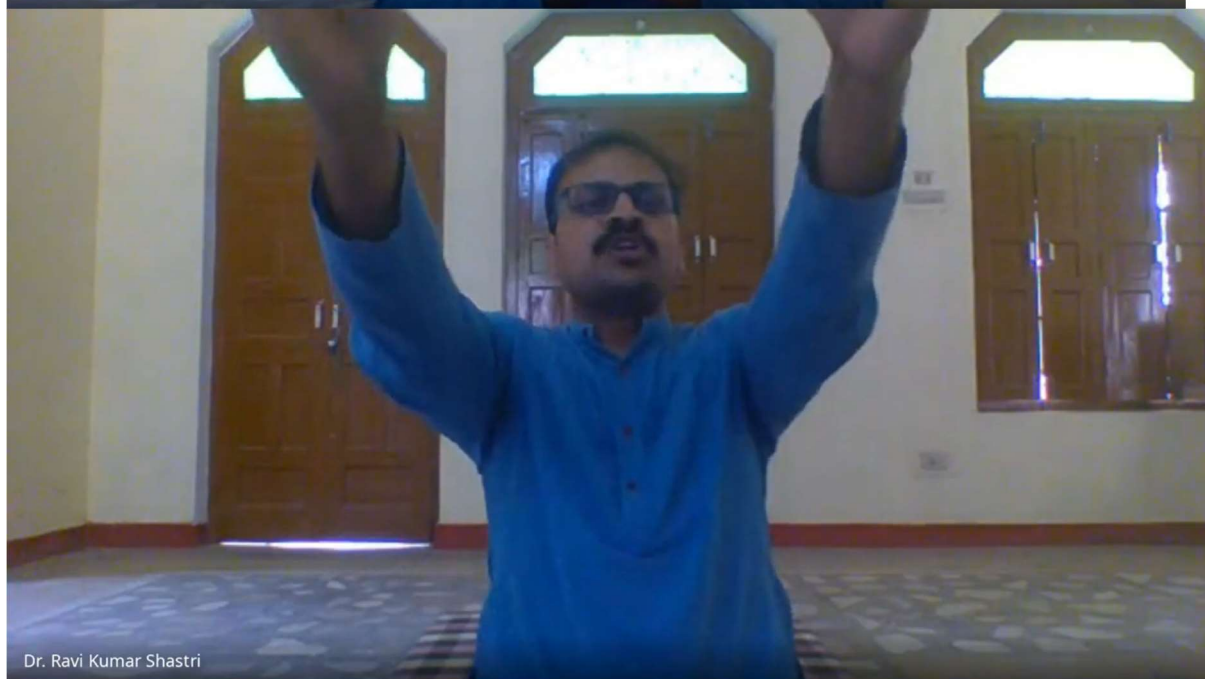

Following the Prime Minister's clarion call on 2nd October 2014 for each individual to devote at least 100 hours to Swachhata through the year, the Ministry of Human Resource Development in association with the Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation has launched the 'Swachh Bharat Summer Internship - 100 Hours of Swachhata'.

The program aims to:

- Develop skill and orientation of youth for sanitation related work
- Bring youth across the country an opportunity to make a significant contribution to the swachhata revolution
- Integrate youth in the community service in rural areas in the run up to the 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi

#### Key Activity of the Internship

At least 100 hour of Swachhata related activities in rural areas

#### Duration

100 hours (between 1st May to 31st July 2018)

#### Eligibility

Students enrolled in Colleges/ Universities (referred to as "parent institution") may apply through the enrolment form.

Candidates are eligible to choose between the State of Residence and State of Parent Institution as the location of internship (village/district)

Candidates may participate individually or in teams.

The location and team size (maximum limit of 10 members) may be decided in consultation with Nodal Officers.





The NSS wing of Sri Venkateswara College, University of Delhi that, with an attempt to jump out of the bandwagon, has been an ardent believer of 'change with continuity' and discarding the conventional idea of red letter days for action oriented goals that social service is often associated with. The newly college society- turned- NSS- wing had its first tryst with change in the form of the PM initiated 'Swachchh Bharat Abhiyan' framework that comprised of keeping under check the cleanliness within and outside their college premise, spreading awareness among the members from the community right adjacent to the college and going to public places for carrying out similar activities.

In the sweltering Delhi heat of 10th August, when almost everyone was in a haste to retire from the day's work, a bunch of 20 college students battling the heat, were heading towards the National Railway Museum in South Delhi. All armed with plastic hand-gloves, posters that screamed of the duties as a citizen and garbage bags that were later brimming with the sins of our asleep conscience, the students divided themselves into groups of 4 and spread in all directions. Usually, we find public spaces such as these to be highly maintained and supposedly clean. The scenario, however, was in stark contrast to the expectations with plastic bottles, aluminium foils, cartons and wrappers comprising of most of the garbage that these spaces manufacture. Beginning with the area in front of the Indoor Gallery to the nooks and corners of all the model trains that were stationed there, they collected garbage of all types from the tracts, dumping them in the bins, refilling and continuing with the process until they were interrupted by the incessant rainfall. In compensation to the work, the students got dispersed in the vast area of the museum as the rain subsided and began interacting with the visitors and the passers-by regarding cleanliness and what they understood of their roles.

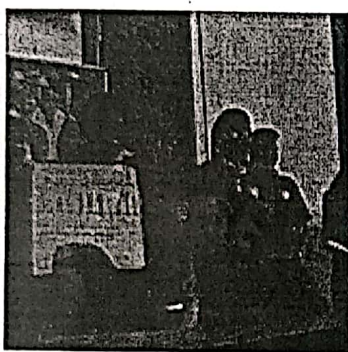

## **Activity 72**

### **AYUDH: A Fight Against Drug Menace –Oct 2018**

AYUDH- an international youth movement initiative taken up by Mata Amritanandamayi Devi, lovingly known as 'amma' and renowned for giving away larger than life hugs; the "hugging- saint", in collaboration with other international organizations has come up with ways to tackle menaces that affect the youth worldwide by incorporating the stake holders themselves.

NSS-SVC organized a session with AYUDH on 8<sup>th</sup> of October with three representatives from the esteemed Amrita Vishva Vidyapeeth, Delhi. It was really amazing to see the diverse backgrounds that the volunteers ranged from- analysts, computer science engineers to a corporate worker in the fashion industry. The intensity of participation was clearly the indication of being able to do one's own bit.

The session commenced with a small prayer, followed by a highly interactive session including a bunch of games and ice-breaking activities that emphasized on the need for concentration and a calm and composed mind to be able to excel in today's era considering the pace at which modernity and competition are swaying away every individual leaving them with absolutely no time for themselves. In this context, the speakers also elaborated upon the fading importance of the Indian culture in present status quo and their added scientific value; for example, from the explanation behind applying sandalwood or 'chandam' between the brows and the need to sit straight to touching the feet of elders and the importance of hands as being pertinent to the transfer of energy. The importance of this energy came explicitly to be asserted as a characteristic of the youth and how this energy needs to be conserved by firstly, investing it in the right place.

Now the main contention with the notion of the "right place" ended with the youth's responsibility to tackle the menaces that they have been victims to, majorly. This rightly directed the entire session towards discussing about the major problem that we, as youth, face today- drug abuse.

Problems do not always manifest themselves through physicality with drug abuse being the epitome to it. From resorting to it the night right before exams

in order to be able to stay awake, to facing an existential crisis in its absence due to addiction leading to loss of sense of the conscious world; the entire idea of individual choice falters as soon as we take into consideration the harms that it causes to our health- making our bodies squeeze and weak- and consequently, the society at large. It is important to start treating a menace as a menace and not just as a “normal” choice. Normalization of such menaces is synonymous to supporting them, thereby, leading to their aggravation. Hence, the need to identify such people at the earliest.

Moving on, talking about AYUDH’s work on ground zero led to really inspiring revelations including them having adopted 110 villages in the remotest areas across India. Addressing other issues such as gender disparity, sanitation and environmental causes, a couple of videos were presented that sent out the message for the need of awareness in present status quo before coming up with a solution.

The enlightening session, having disseminated cultural knowledge and awareness, concluded with the need of the hour boiling down to making the youth aware of their own problems in the very first place, before dipping their feet in other conflicting waters, since, the very need is to being human to one another and not a savior.

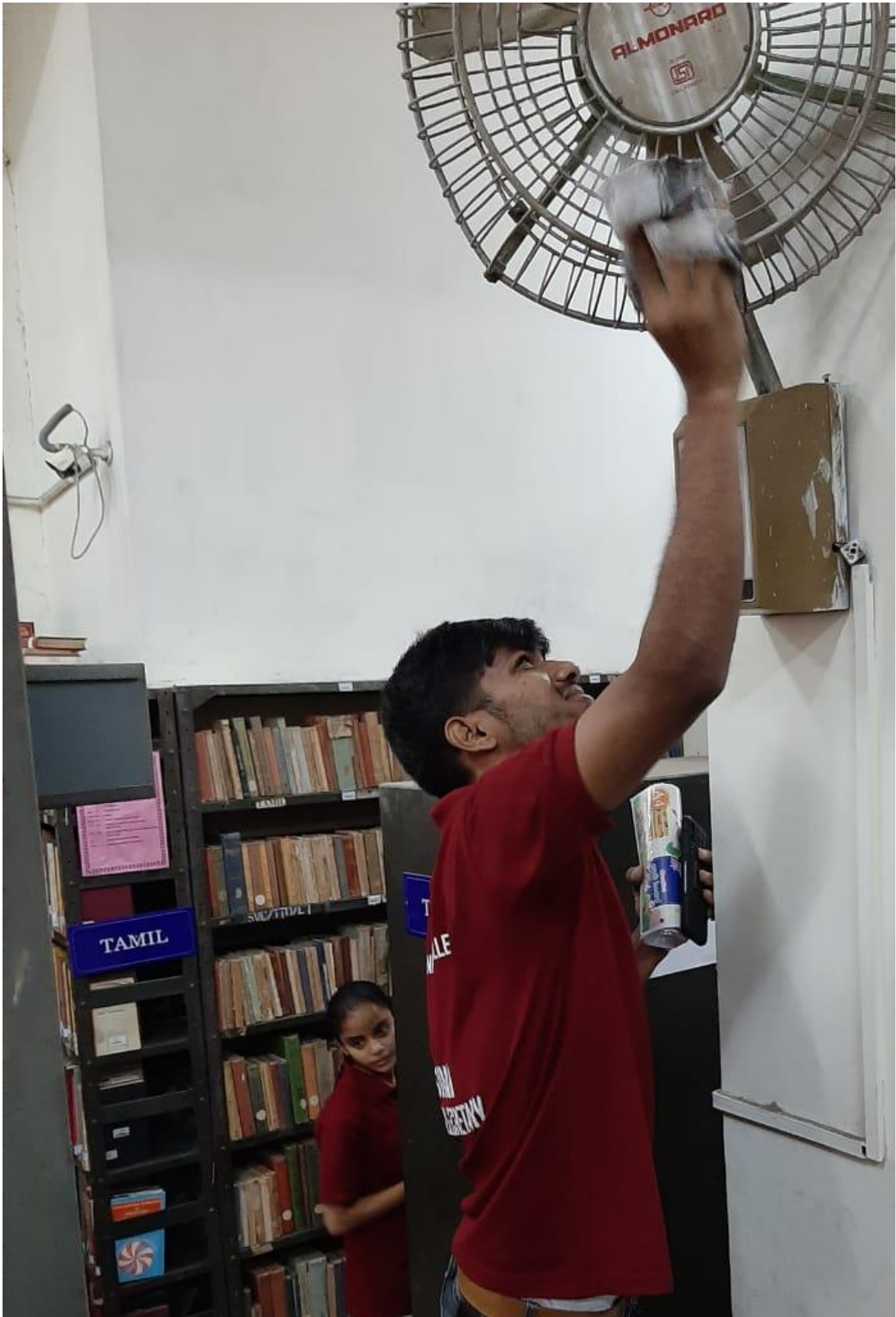
SWACHATHA HI SWACHATA
