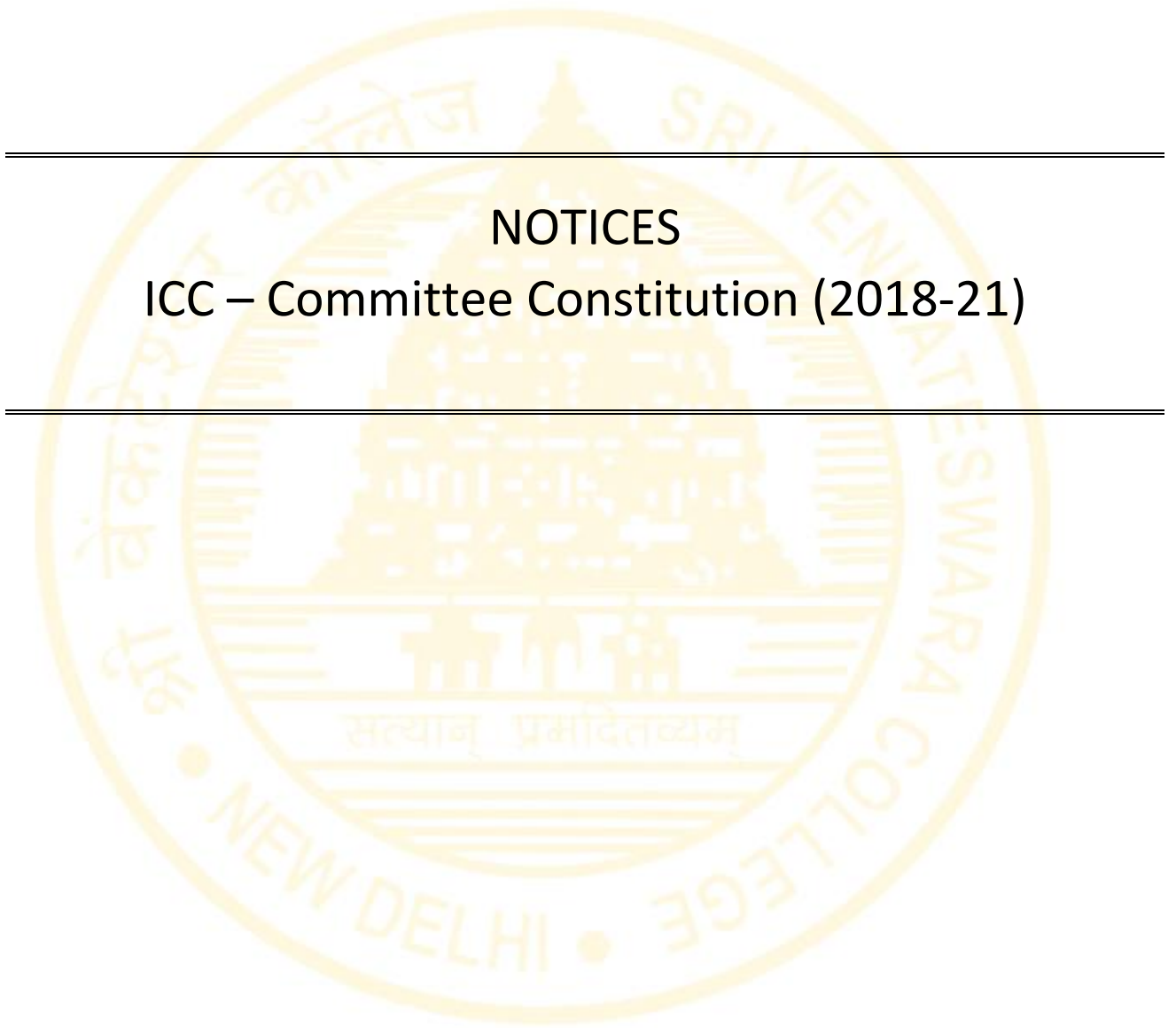


Term of the student members to the ICC

- b) The Student Representatives to the ICC shall, in no case, have a term beyond one year.

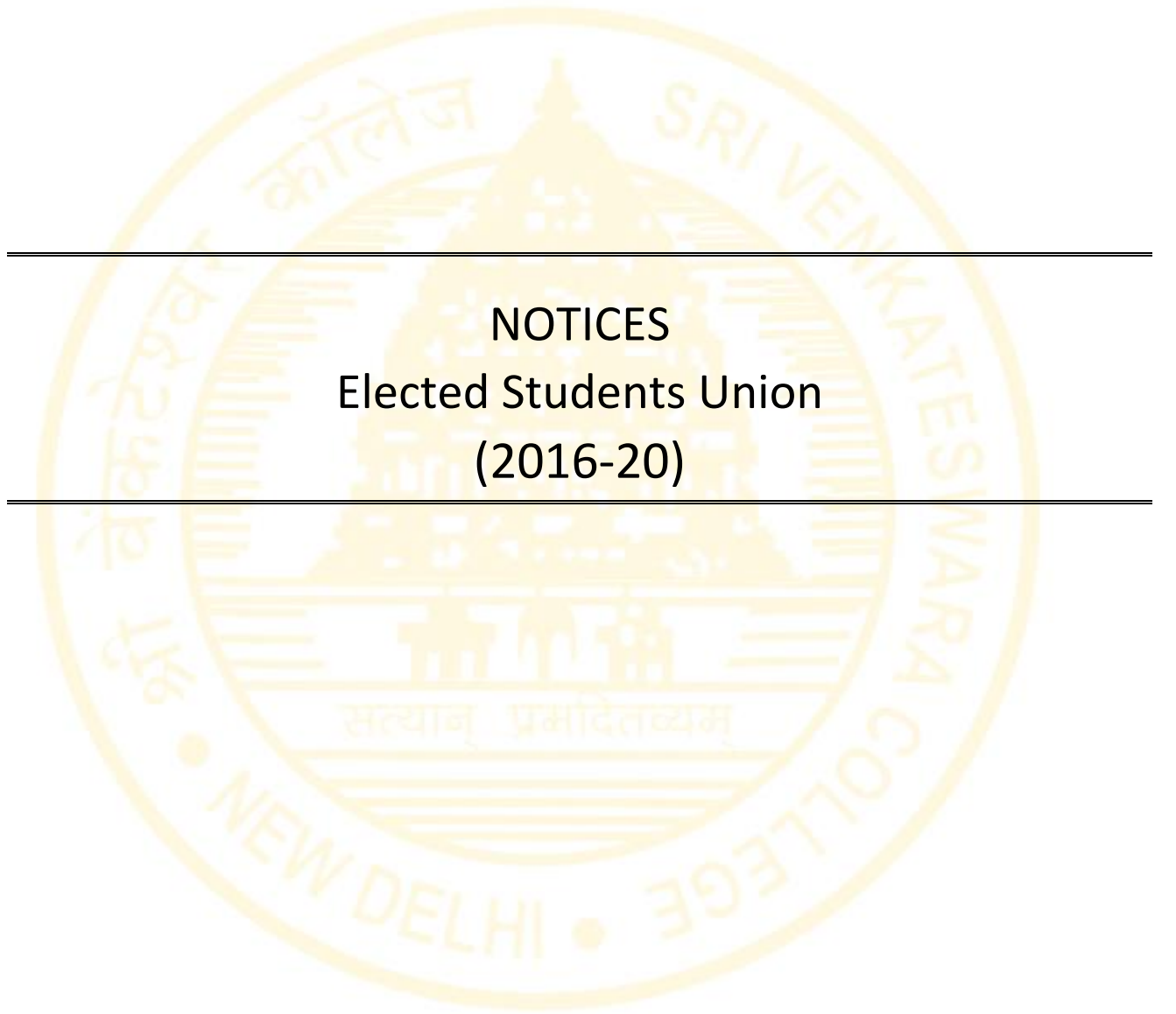

- non availability of a new edition of books and readings in the library

Of all the problems faced by the students, the students chose to move further with the issue of non-availability of books in the library which consequently results in spending a huge chunk in buying expensive books every semester.

The students confronted with the unorganized and cluttered books in the library. Books of old editions were also a major issue among students. Adding to it, a number of books available for specific courses were proportionately less in comparison to the number of students. Furthermore, books had to be submitted before exams. The college libraries have a greater advantage for tapping new edition of books, but it's very difficult for students to find them instantly in the market

Finally, a big shout out our amazing audience and each and every member of Team A.S.C.E.N.D for making it possible to conduct so many activities in a semester.



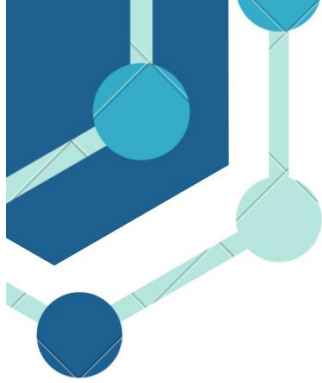

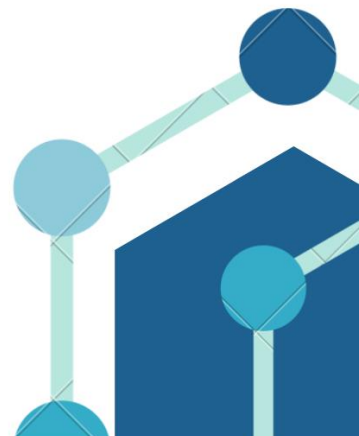


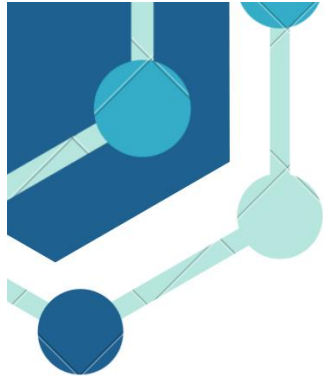


FRESHMAN ORIENTATION

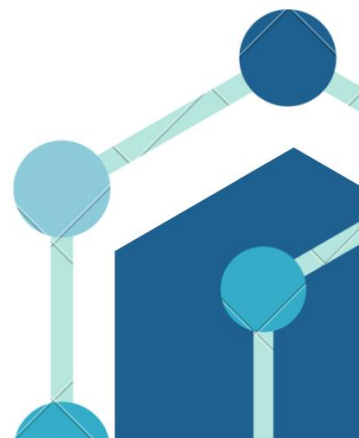

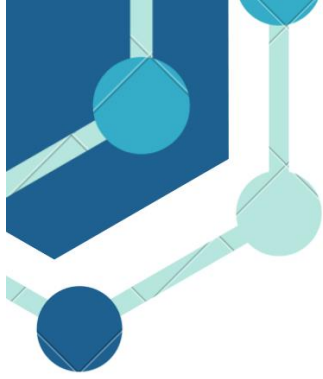




ICE-BREAKING SESSION

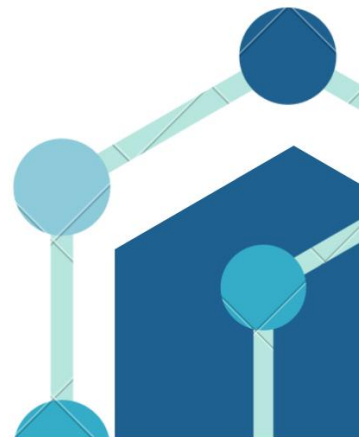




BEYOND THE TANK 1.0

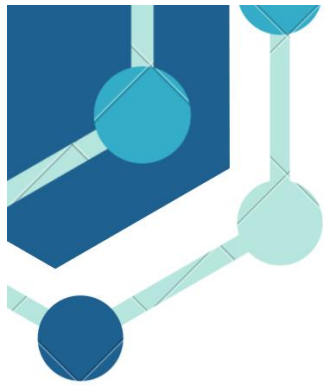




ILLUMINATE WORKSHOP 2.0

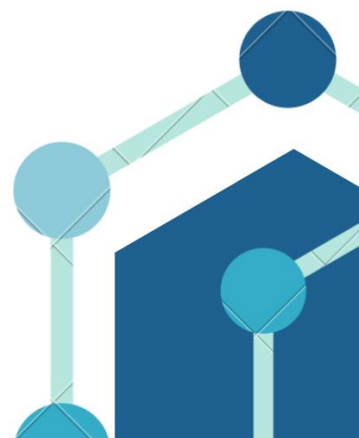

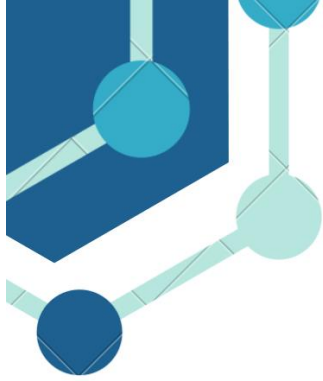




A VISIT TO SANJAYA CAMP

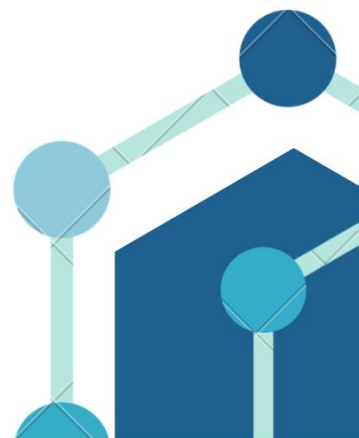


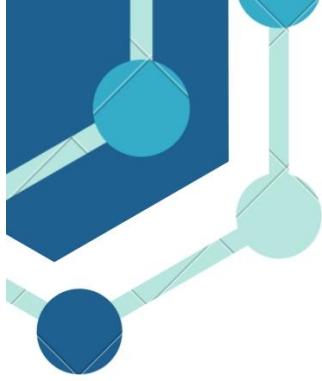


BEYOND THE TANK 2.0

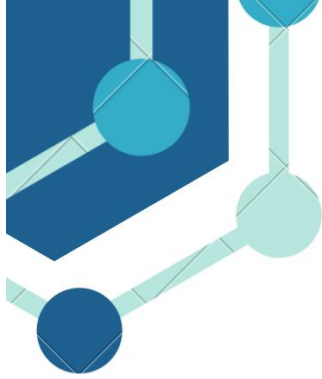
TEST YOUR WIT: SACRED GAMES

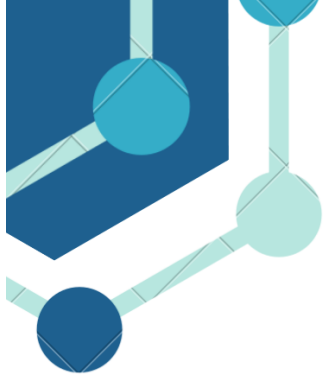

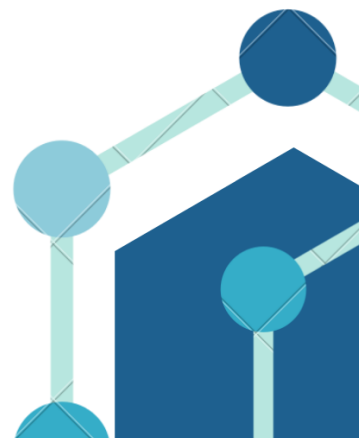

The speaker introduced the audience to the wide disparity in labour supply-demand and the rising need for qualified personnel in fields of FinTech, STEM based courses and many others.





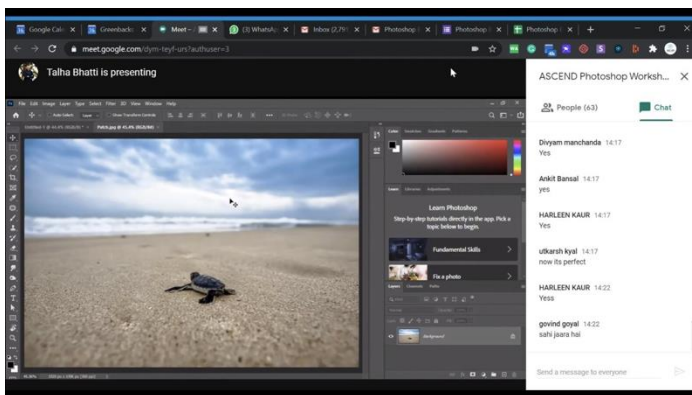

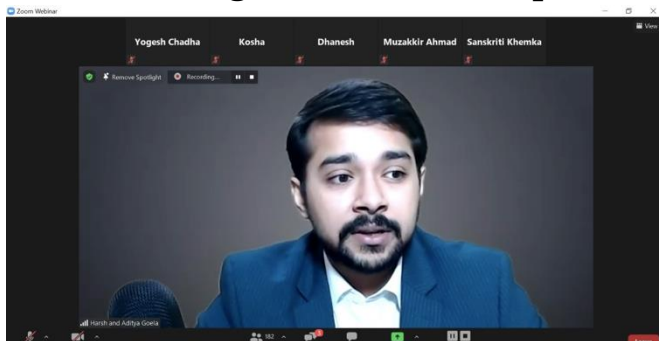

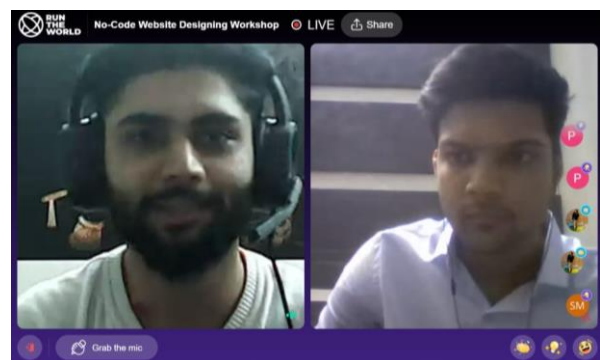
The inauguration was followed by back-to-back speaker sessions from eminent entrepreneurs on a wide range of topics:

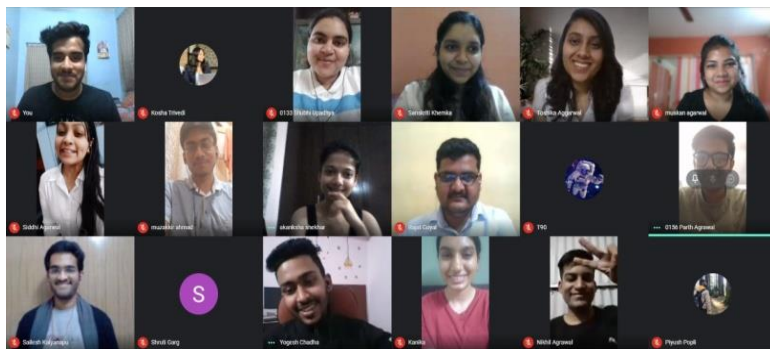

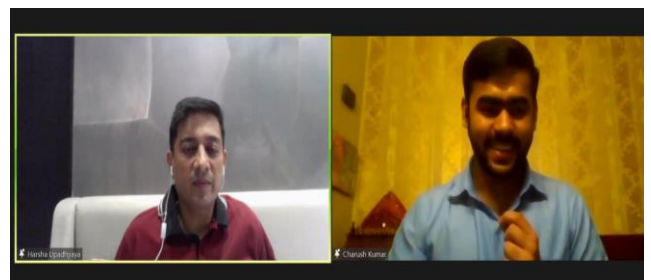

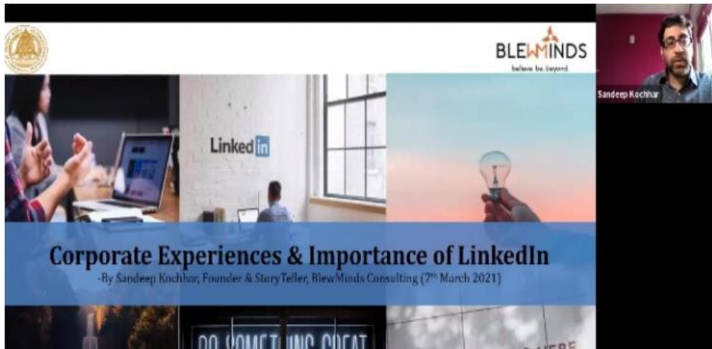
