



Finally, a big shout out our amazing audience and each and every member of Team A.S.C.E.N.D for making it possible to conduct so many activities in a semester.



We also initiated SVC's first, very own start-up, "University Kart", in the year 2018.


We regularly conduct seminars and skill development workshops to foster the spirit of entrepreneurship.






Sustainability is a necessity in all facets of business today. The long term vision of the society involves creating a sustainable platform that shall ensure the existence, relevance and viability of the society.





- Interactive informal session to highlight the essence of entrepreneurship









SESSION IS COLLEGE THE RIGHT TIME TO START-UP?






BEYOND THE TANK 1.0







BEYOND THE TANK 2.0




SESSION THE JOURNEY OF A STARTUP FROM 0 TO 1





We stand #1 in the Delhi University circuit and have established one of the strongest Entrepreneurship Cells in the University.







A blend of creativity, communication and collaboration, this event marked the end of E-TALK 2020!










SPONSOR SESSION CAREER OPTIONS IN THE USA 5 MARCH 2020
