This is a curated program for students aged 18 or over who wish to visit the UK and have an educational and cultural experience. The course is a combination of time on the NTU campus and time on location in the city and region exploring museums, galleries and visitor attractions that will support their learning.

The Program:

Branding, Design and Communication - for a Better World!

This course combines ethical brand development with industry-level graphic design. It's for students with some design experience who want to deepen their knowledge of branding through a structured, meaningful project. With an emphasis on communication and visualisation skills using Adobe Creative Suite, you'll create a brand from the point of view of a creative thinker and as an advocate for a cause.

On this course, you'll practice a range of skills to create a brand. Your brand will respond to a professional brief around a current social, political or environmental issue. It will include graphic design, fashion communication, marketing, art direction and creative storytelling. You'll also learn how to employ quality research techniques, consumer profiling and professional visual creation.

On this course, you will:

- become a better critical thinker
- · learn how to contextualise an idea
- \cdot discuss current events and issues and their impact on design
- · complete consumer research
- practice creating graphic design content that speaks to your audience
- · explore trend forecasting and visual mood boards
- · develop your software skills
- expand your graphic design knowledge in font-pairing, document set-up, time-savers and product mock-ups
- prepare ways to present your ideas and develop storytelling for a brand.

The course will include lectures, discussions and critiques combined with practical work, independent study and visits to places locally that provide creative design inspiration. Plus visits or talks from groups involved in the environment, sustainability and community action.

By the end of this course, you'll have created new work for a professional design portfolio and have expanded your critical thinking and market intelligence skills. You'll leave having made a proposal to the rest of the group for your brand idea and have gained confidence in your professional presentation and communication skills.











Destination - Nottingham City

Nottingham is a gorgeous city with a ton to see and explore. If you're plotting out an England itinerary, you should definitely add in a stop in this historic city.

The National Justice Museum is an independent museum on High Pavement in the Lace Market area of Nottingham, England. The museum is housed in a former Victorian courtroom, prison, and police station and is therefore a historic site where an individual could be arrested, tried, sentenced and executed. Nottingham Contemporary is one of the largest contemporary art galleries in the UK, presenting exhibitions, special events, and family activities.
