## List of GE Languages offered to B.A.(Prog)/B. Com (Prog)

(For the Semester II/IV of the academic year 2023-2024)

All the students of B.A.(Prog)/B. Com (Prog) Undergraduate Courses of Semester-II/IV are directed to opt any one GE -Language paper different from their core disciplines as per details given below.

## The students are required to go though the following details before opting for a GE paper:

1. All B. A. (Prog.) and B. Com (Prog.) students can choose any one GE paper from a pool of languages (English, Hindi, Sanskrit, Tamil, Telugu) offered by the college.

#### 2. Semester II students:

- a. Please choose GE II-Language offered by the departments of Hindi/English/Tamil/Telugu/Sanskrit only.
- b. Those students from **BA Programme** who want to take Hindi as one of the languages in GE, should opt for Sem II (Hindi GE for BA prog), and, wait for the other language in the next semester.
- **c.** Those students from **B. Com Programme** who want to take English as one of the languages in GE should opt for Sem II (English GE for BCom prog), and, wait for the other language in the next semester.
- d. GE-II language should be different from GE-I language.

#### 3. Semester IV students:

- **a.** Please choose one GE IV-Language from those offered by the departments of Hindi/English/ Tamil/ Telugu/Sanskrit only.
- b. GE Language for Semester IV should be the same as chosen for Semester II.

## 4. For students choosing Hindi as GE language it may be noted that :

- a. Hindi A: For students who have studied Hindi upto class 12<sup>th</sup>.
- b. Hindi B: For students who have studied Hindi upto class 10th
- c. Hindi C: For students who have studied Hindi upto class 8th
- 5. Students of B.A. program with two languages as the core disciplines can choose from the open pool of Generic Electives (and not restricted to choose only the GE-Languages)
- 6. Students of B.A. program with one language as the core disciplines can choose only one GE-language (which will be two courses of the same language that may be studied as GE-1 and GE-3 or GE-2 and GE-4). The other GEs shall be the open pool of GEs offered by college.
- 7. GE Language cannot be same as the language chosen as core paper of the student.
- 8. B.A./B.Com. Programme students who have never studied any Modern Indian Language (MIL) up to 8th Class can choose from the open pool of GEs.
- 9. Discrepancy, if any in the GE as mentioned above, may kindly be brought to the notice of the office of the SO (Admin) and/or dealing assistants of the respective courses in the Administration immediately, for the necessary modification.
- 10. A common online form link to fill the options shall be circulated by 10<sup>th</sup> January, 2024. The last date for filling/changing the GE option will be 30<sup>th</sup> January, 2024. No change shall be entertained after that.
