Medals/Prizes/Scholarships Guidelines

<u>Academic Prizes</u>: Academic Prizes in each Course are awarded to the top-ranking students on the basis of the last Annual Examination held by the University of Delhi;

- 1. <u>Balaji Medal (30 Grams) to DU Topper</u>:- A student who tops the Delhi University at the end of the III Year Examination will be awarded the Balaji Medal (30 Grams) Silver Dollars along with appreciation certificate which is instituted by the college with effect from the academic year 2015-2016.
- 2. <u>Balaji Medal (20 Grams) to UDSC Topper)</u>:- A student who tops the University of Delhi South Campus at the end of the III Year Examination will be awarded the Balaji Medal (20 Grams) Silver Dollars along with appreciation certificate which is instituted by the college with effect from the academic year 2015-2016.
- 3. <u>Students Union Merit Awards (30 Grams Silver Medals)</u>:- These Awards, instituted by the Students Union in 1982-83, will be awarded to the students securing the highest marks in the Final Year Examination among the students of our College in the following courses:- B.A.& B.A.(Hons) Programme, B.Com(Pass) & B.Com(Hons), B.Sc.& B.Sc(Hons). In addition to the above, any other student of our college securing the First Position in the University in any of the courses will also be awarded.
- 4. <u>Lord Venkateswara Merit Awards (30 Grams Silver Medals)</u>:- These Awards, instituted by Prof CSGK Setty, Department of Physics and Astrophysics will be awarded as follows:- (a) To the best student in Sciences at the I Year University Examination and (b) To the best student in Arts at the I Year University Examination.
- 5. <u>GV Subramanyam Memorial Medals</u> (30 <u>Grams Silver Medals</u>):- In memory of late Mr GV Subramanyam, Department of English, a medal each will be awarded to the best student of the III Year of B.A.(Hons)English and B.A.(Programme)Elective English.
- 6. <u>Seema Katyal Memorial Prize (30 Grams Silver Medals)</u>:- In memory of an old student Seema Katyal, a prize will be given to the students securing highest marks in B.A./B.Sc(Hons)Mathematics II Year.

Dr ES Narayanan Medals and Prizes (30 Grams Silver Medals) :-

- a) Sri Narayanan Ayyar and Parvati Memorial Medal will be awarded to the student who secures I Position in B.A.(Hons)Sanskrit III Year.
- b) Sri Sundara Ayyar and Alamelu Memorial Medal will be awarded to the student who secures I Position in B.A./B.Sc(Hons)Mathematics III Year.

c) Smt Sita Naryanann Memorial Medal will be awarded to the students who secures I Position in B.Sc(Hons)Botany III Year.

- 7. <u>Soundarya Nayaki Govindswamy Memorial Medal</u> (30 Grams Silver Medals):- It will be awarded to the student who secures I Position in B.A.(Hons)Economics III Year.
- 8. <u>Emani's Medals (30 Grams Silver Medals)</u>:- It will be awarded to the students who secure highest marks in Ancient Indian History (a) B.A.(Programme) and (b) B.A.(Hons) Programme.
- 9. <u>Balaji Merit Medal</u> (30 Grams Silver Medals):- It will be awarded to the student who secures I Position in B.Sc(Hons)Zoology III Year.
- 10. <u>Dr (Ms) P Sarojini Reddy Scholarships (30 Grams Silver Medals)</u>:- It will be awarded to two girl students, one each of B.A.(Hons)Political Science I Year and B.A.(Pass)Political Science I Year, on the criteria of Economic backwardness.
- 11. <u>Srimati Velagalety Suvarchalamba Memorial Prizes (30 Grams Silver Medals)</u>:- Two prizes will be awarded to the students of Sri Venkateswara College, New Delhi, who secure :
 - a) the highest Marks in the B.Sc(Hons) Examination of the University of Delhi in Chemistry; and
 - b) the highest marks at the final year University Examination (in any Honours Course).
- 12. <u>Sri Velagalety Lakshmi Narasimha Rao Memorial Prize</u> (30 Grams Silver Medals):- An academic prize will be awarded to the student of Sri Venkateswara College, New Delhi, who secures highest aggregate of Marks at the Final Year Honours Examination of the University of Delhi from among the students other than those belonging to Science Stream, Mathematics and Statistics.
- 13. <u>G Sabrinath Memorial Award (15 Grams Silver Medals)</u>:- It will be awarded to the top ranking student from the College in B.Sc(Hons) Chemistry II Year Examination of the University of Delhi.
- 14. <u>Sultan Chand Trust Merit Scholarships (Cash)</u>:- M/s Sultan Chand Trust have instituted two scholarships of Rs 375/- Per Month to the toppers in B.Com (Hons) I Year and II Year, if he/she secures 75% marks or more in his/her university previous examination in the first attempt.
- 15. Bharatula Savitri Memorial Prize (Cash):- Instituted by Prof B Rama Murthy, Prof Emeritus (Retd.), IARI will be awarded to the students standing First at the end of the Final Year (Three Years Aggregate) University Examination in the disciplines of Bio-Chemistry, Bio-Chemical & Molecular Technology, Botany, Chemistry, Physics, Electronics, Mathematics, Zoology, Economics, Sanskrit and Telugu in B.A. (Programme/B.Com II Year Courses. Since Telugu is a subject of study and is taught only in First Year and Second Year as MIL and not as a discipline course till now, the said Prize under this category would be given to the students standing First at the end of the Second Year instead of Final Year, till Telugu is taught as discipline course at B.A. (Programme) level in the college.
- 16. Nelabhatla Venkata Subbiah Memorial Prize (Cash):- Instituted by Prof. B.Rama Murthy, Prof. Emeritus (Retd.), IARI will be awarded to the students standing First at the end of the Final Year (Three Years Aggregate) University Examination in the disciplines of B.Com(Hons); B.A.(Hons) Programme: English, Hindi, History, Political Science, Sociology; B.Sc(Hons): Mathematics and Statistics.
- 17. <u>Dr R Dwaraka Das Memorial Award of Rs 1,000/-PA (Cash):-</u> Instituted by Dr (Ms) Nirmala Dwaraka Das, Ex Reader in the Department of Political Science, Sri Venkateswara College, New Delhi, will be awarded to the students who stand First in B.A.(Hons)Political Science at the end of the Final Year in the University Examinations.

Mrs P.Gupta Meritorius Awards (Medals 30 Silver Grams):-Instituted by Mrs P.Gupta, Ex. Museum Curator, Sri Venkateswara College, will be awarded to the students securing highest marks in Delhi University examinations at the end of III Year in B.Sc(Hons) Zoology, Botany and B.Sc Life Sciences and also to the students securing highest marks at the end of III Year in Entomology and Taxonomy subjects in B.Sc(Hons)Zoology and Botany, respectively.

Students desirous of leaving the studies mid-way without completing the PG Degree will have to take prior approval from the UGC by submitting an application along with justification through the concerned University. - Post-Graduate Indira Gandhi Scholarship Scheme for Single Girl Child :- Any single girl child of her 24. parents will be eligible under the scheme. The scheme is applicable to such a single girl child who has taken admission in any Master's Degree Programme in the College. The duration of Scholarship is two years and the rate of Scholarship is Rs 2000/- per month. Besides, no tuition fees will be charged from such girls should they decide to pursue their Master's Degree in the College/University. - (i) If in Fourth Semester two candidate secure equal number of marks, the value of the Scholarship shall be divided equally between them.
- (ii) In case the student securing the highest percentage of marks in B.Com. Hons Fourth Semester University Examination is in receipt of any other Scholarship or is unwilling to accept this Scholarship, the same shall be awarded to the next eligible candidates strictly by merit.
- e) No student shall be eligible for this Scholarship if he/she already holds a Scholarship awarded by Delhi University or any other University or the Central Govt. or any State Govt. or a Private Body except free ship.
- In case student awarded this Scholarship accepts any other Scholarship/financial assistance from any other source, he/she shall be require to surrender this Scholarship and also refund the amount received by him/her on account of this Scholarship from the date he/she accepts the other Scholarship / financial assistance.
- g) In case student discontinues studies without valid reasons, the Scholarship also is discontinued immediately.
- h) In case Scholarship falls Vacant, it may be awarded for the residuary period to another eligible student by
- Any amount accruing from the interest from the endowment and not spent during the fifth Semester shall be added to the corpus of the endowment fund.
- The payment of the Scholarship amount will be made to the student on presentation of certificate to the effect that during the period he/she was not in receipt of any other Scholarship or financial assistance from any other source.
- k) A report of the award of Scholarship will be furnished to the donor Trust each time. It may contain Full Name and address of the Topper, Total Marks got, Paperwise Marks got, Phone No. (Residential), Title of Books/ Authors for B.Com. Hons. used by the Topper.

- 42. <u>Late Dr Jita Mishra Memorial Meritorious Scholarship</u>:- Instituted by Dr Aditya Narayan Mishra, in the memory of his wife late Dr Jita Mishra, Associate Professor, Department of Political Science, Sri Venkateswara College, New Delhi, will be awarded (in consultation with the Political Science Department) to a meritorious student from the Department of Political Science who comes from a financially weaker background. He further requested to conduct an annual lecture entitled "Dr Jita Mishra Annual Lecture" in his wife's name in the college w.e.f. the academic year 2024-2025.
- In the memory of Late Cheistha Kochhar (alumnus of Sri Venkateswara College) who completed her B.A. (Hons) Economics from the college during the academic years 2008-2011), the endowment of Rs. 500000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs) only has been instituted by her parents, Mrs. and Lt. Gen (Dr.) SP Kochhar. After drawing for one time cost of the Rolling Trophy for the best debating team, (which shall be designed at the college end), the Interest accruals from the corpus shall be divided in the ratio 7:2:1, as requested by the parents, for the purposes listed below:
- (a) Late Cheistha Kochhar Scholarship:- Seven-tenth of the interest accruals of the corpus shall be for a scholarship for the set of third year undergraduate students of financially needy of the college who are shortlisted by the Freeship Committee, based on the criterion set from time to time. After shortlisting student applicants with a minimum CGPA of 8 in Semester IV and a high recommendation by the parent department, the student with the lowest annual family income among them shall be identified and awarded the scholarship. The Committee may hold an interaction with the student identified for the award.
- (b) <u>Late Cheistha Kochhar Annual Lecture</u>:- 2/10th of the interest accruals of the corpus shall be utilized towards organizing an **Annual Lecture** in the **Department of Economics** in memory of Ms. Cheistha Kochhar.
- (c) <u>Late Cheistha Kochhar Rolling Trophy and the Best Debator in English Prize</u>:- 1/10th of the interest accruals from the corpus shall be given as the cash prize to the Best Debator Late Chelstha Kochhar Rolling Trophy shall be for the best debating team. The English Debating Society (of which Cheistha was a part of) will be in charge of the same.

The eligible college students may download/obtain the necessary application form and copy of the rules & regulation governing the award/medal as per requirement from the website of the respective Institution/Organization. The application form duly filled in and signed and completed in all the respects may be submitted within the stipulated time as per notification, if applicable, for further necessary action within the stipulated period.

Note:-

- 1. <u>If it is found at any stage that any information submitted is misleading or incorrect, disciplinary action shall be intimated against the defaulter(s), as per rules.</u>
- 2.
