## NOTIFICATION

All the students pursuing Undergraduate Courses of Semester II/IV/VI are directed to fill GE/DSE options on or before 21st January, 2025 by logging on to their Student Administrative System (SAS) ERP Portal.

### Note:

1. Check the eligibility/pre-requisites for the courses and apply only if you are eligible/fulfill prerequisites for the course.
2. The students must go through the detailed instructions given below as well as provided on ERP, before filling in the option form.
3. Provide three distinct choices in order of preference for GE courses.
4. **The choices can be edited any number of times till the final deadline.** However, after the form is closed, no further editing will be allowed.
5. A student who intends to make a discipline as minor, must ensure that he/she takes **three compulsory** GEs of that department apart from four other GEs offered by such department in the GE pool. 6. Students admitted in the Academic year 2022-23 and 2023-24, are allowed to study mandatory GEs of the discipline/department they are planning to make as a minor, irrespective of the pre-requisites prescribed for these GEs.
7. For Choosing GE/DSE course, it is important that a student also goes through the Website notification regarding modalities of making a minor discipline, using the link: [https://svc.ac.in/SVC\\_MAIN/Notice/Notice2024/DU%20Notification\\_Modalities%20to%20develop%20Minor%20Discipline.pdf](https://svc.ac.in/SVC_MAIN/Notice/Notice2024/DU%20Notification_Modalities%20to%20develop%20Minor%20Discipline.pdf)
8. Students must not opt for any GE paper if the syllabus of the GE has more than 30% similarity to any DSC/DSE/GE paper studied so far or to be studied in the following semesters as part of their curriculum. The student may consult their respective Teacher-in-Charge to seek clarifications in this regard.
9. The number of seats in some GE courses are limited and the allocation in these courses will be on First Come First Serve basis.
10. The college may not always be able to provide the student's first choice. So, provide your second and third preferences with due consideration.

11. Approving any request for a change in GE/DSE option later is entirely at the discretion of the college. Therefore, the student should be careful in making the initial choices.
12. It is mandatory for all to fill in the GE/DSE registration form. For any clarification, you may write to the coordinator at: [gecommittee@svc.ac.in](mailto:gecommittee@svc.ac.in).

#### **For all courses:**

- **Students pursuing Hons. Courses:** Students cannot opt for a GE offered by the parent department. For example, a student pursuing Hindi (Hons.), can opt for GE of any department other than Hindi Department.
- **Students pursuing Hons. Courses:** Students of Semester II choose only one GE.
- **Students pursuing Hons. Courses:** Students of Semester IV choose GE /DSE(Non-parent)/ DSE (parent).
- **Students pursuing Hons. Courses:** Students of Semester VI choose one GE and one DSE (parent).
- 7 GEs taken for a particular department qualifies students for a minor in that subject, provided they have a major degree.
- Major is only possible after 8<sup>th</sup> Semester.

#### **For BA Prog students**

- GE should be different from core subjects.
- All B. A. (Prog.) students can choose any one GE paper from a pool of languages (English, Hindi, Sanskrit, Tamil, Telugu) or other GE courses offered by the college.
- SEM II and SEM IV students with no language as core MUST choose Hindi as GE at SVC.
- SEM II and IV students with Hindi language as core, can choose GE from the open pool or choose any other Modern Indian Language (MIL) from GEL Pool.
- SEM VI students can choose GE from the open pool, since they have done languages in SEM I-IV.
- SEM VI students choose DSE (major or minor discipline).

- For GE, SEM VI students cannot take DSE of non-parent department, since the DSE slots are common for all departments
- Students opting for Hindi as GE must note the following:
  - (i) Hindi A -for students who studied Hindi upto class XII
  - (ii) Hindi B- for students who studied Hindi upto class X
  - (iii) Hindi C- for students who studied Hindi upto class VIII
- Students with one language as the core discipline can choose only one GE-language (which will be two courses of the same language, which may be studied as GE-1 and GE-3 or GE-2 and GE-4). The other two GEs shall be from the open pool of GEs. For BAP students at SVC, English is offered in odd semesters and Hindi is offered in the even semesters.
- B.A.P students who have never studied any Modern Indian Language (MIL) up to 8th Class can choose from the open pool of GEs.
- The GE language in SEM II should be different from the language chosen in SEM I.
- The GE language in SEM IV should be the same as the language chosen in SEM II.

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### For B.Com. students

- All B.Com. (Prog.) students can choose any one GE paper from a pool of languages (English, Hindi, Sanskrit, Tamil, Telugu).
- SEM II and SEM IV students of SVC to choose English as GE.
- The GE language in SEM II should be different from the language chosen in SEM I.
- The GE Language in SEM IV should be same as in Semester II.
- B.Com. Program students who have never studied any Modern Indian Language (MIL) up to 8th Class can choose from the open pool of GEs.
- For GE, SEM VI cannot take DSE of non-parent department, since the DSE slots are common for all departments.

### For Life science students:

- They can take GE from departments other than Chem, Botany and Zoology.
- They need to choose DSE offered by the departments of Chem/Bot/Zoology only.
- Semester IV students may opt for DSE of Chemistry, Botany, Zoology in place of GE.
- The concept of major and minor comes only if the students pursue 8 semesters of UG course.
- Students can get minor either Chem/Bot/Zoology.
- Students cannot get minor in non-core subjects, since they need to do 9 DSE for major. This leaves the option for 5 GE so 28 points cannot be accumulated for a minor in non-core papers.
- The students of SEM IV/VI who are not looking for major in any core discipline, may choose GE in SEM IV and DSE from any parent department in SEM VI.

- For a major degree, choose DSE, in major discipline, in semester III/IV, and then in all the semesters, starting from SEM V, and do dissertation in that stream in both Sem VII and VIII. For details, students may contact the Life science/GE coordinator.
- LS students want to choose dissertation in SEM VII, must do DSE Research methodology in SEM VI.
- LS students who also want a minor degree after fourth year must do one DSE, in minor discipline, in SEM III/IV/V.

**For Bioscience students:**

- They can opt for any GE from the GE Pool.
- SEM IV and SEM VI students can only take DSEs designated for the Biosc. For more details, please contact your BioSc. Coordinator.
