




CORPORATE PLACEMENT TRAINING SESSION BY DELOITTE USI DATE: 5TH JULY, 2021




INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE IN YIF PROGRAM BY ASHOKA UNIVERSITY DATE: 5th AUGUST 2021




WEBINAR ON CYBER HYGIENE IN PANDEMIC BY SAGE SECURITY DATE: 28th AUGUST, 2021






SESSION ON CAT'22: THE ROAD AHEAD BY CAREER LAUNCHER DATE: 6th OCTOBER, 2021


WEBINAR ON FINANCIAL FITNESS BY VDART GROUP DATE: 13th OCTOBER, 2021




SESSION ON MOCK INTERVIEWS BY <u>T.I.M.E.</u> DATE: - 9th FEBRUARY, 2022
