Do you see the world around you through a unique eye? Do you think the world around you can be described in a collage? If yes, then here is a competition for you.

Collage is a technique of an art production, primarily used in the visual arts, where the artwork is made from an assemblage of different forms, thus creating a new whole. The term collage (from the French: coller, "to glue";) was coined by both Georges Braque and Pablo Picasso in the beginning of the 20th century when collage became a distinctive part of modern art. A collage may sometimes include magazine and newspaper clippings, ribbons, paint, bits of colored or handmade papers, portions of other artwork or texts, photographs and other found objects, glued to a piece of paper. The focus of this event is on experimenting imaginatively with collage to both help generate ideas and to also produce some 'complete' works of art.

RULES TO REMEMBER!

1. It is an event for individual participation

2. The Collage should be made on the theme of the event "Ornithology".

3. Collage should be in the shape of birds, their nests (Examples shown in the pictures).

4. The collage can be made on A3 (11.7 x 16.5 inches) or A2 sized sheets (16.5 x 23.4 inches) or larger.

5. Real Images of bird (s) from magazine or newspaper should NOT be used.

6. Two files need to be sent

- a. Participants holding the collage in their hands
- b. The picture of the collage itself.

7. Plagiarized images will be disqualified without notice.8. Judgement will be based on creativity, presentation and content.

9. The collage can be made by using news paper cuttings, coloured sheets, thread, beads, etc etc... Feel free to use your creativity...







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
