- Applicants seeking admission to Undergraduate Courses for session 2020-2021 are required to fill the Online Admission Form on the University of Delhi Undergraduate (UG) Admission Portal (<u>https://ug.du.ac.in/</u>)
- ♣ Applicants who wish to be considered for admission to various Undergraduate Courses based on merit are required to register online for all categories, including unreserved (UR) / SC / ST / OBC/EWS.
- Applicants seeking admission under supernumerary categories, namely Reservation of seats for Persons with Disabilities (PwD), Kashmiri Migrant (KM), Reservation for Armed Forces (CW) and Ward Quota shall also apply online on the UG admission portal.
- Extra-curricular and Sports Quota (Supernumerary Seats): It is mandatory for Colleges to provide sports facilities and encourage all students to participate in sports and extracurricular activities by introducing inter-class competitions and mass sports .Applicants seeking admissions under ECA/Sports have to register online at UG Admission Portal.
