Sub: - Dog Menace in College Campus.

Sir,

This has reference to your letter no. SVS/MCD/CT/2015/136-31 dated 15.12.2015 regarding above subject. In view of above, Dog squad has visited Sri Venkateswara College (University of Delhi) Benito Juarez Road, Dhaula Kuan, New Delhi on 31.12.15 and reported that during the Inspection dogs were found in the above area are sterilized. Tip of the right ear of dogs are notched after sterilization as identification mark.

It is informed by the Chairman, AWBI **"barking biting and problematic dogs cannot be impounded and confined in a dog pound, or anywhere else, because it would be illegal to do so. Firstly, all dogs bark and you will appreciate that every dog in Delhi cannot be put away and confined. To do so would be complete violation of the Law"**.

It is further Informed that as per notification dated 24.12.2001 issued by Animal Birth Control (Dog rule 2001,) the dogs are to be released in the same area after sterilization and immunization (rabies) from they had been picked up and the dogs of one area cannot be shifted to another area. It was also informed vide D.O. AWBI/PCA dated 03.03.2008 that "If any Govt. servant Indulges in act of cruelty to animals he will be making himself liable for action under Prevention of cruelty to Animals Act. Besides, punishment under the Act, he would also make himself liable for action under CCS (Conduct) Rules for conduct unbecoming of a govt. Servant" and further directed not to remove the community dogs from the any place as it is illegal and violation of above said rule, this amount to cruelty to animals as per PCA Act and is a punishable offence.
