**NOTIFICATION**

**(Undergraduate Courses : II/IV/VI Semester, 2017)**

All the students of the college are required to attend their classes regularly, as per the rooms allotted and the time-table uploaded on the college website. 66.6% attendance is compulsory for the students to appear at the University of Delhi Semester Examinations to be held in May/June, 2017. The defaulters shall not be permitted to appear at the semester examinations under any circumstances.

Further, there shall be a weightage up to 5 marks for attendance under the Internal Assessment Scheme as per details given below:-


| S.No. | Details of Attendance            | Marks to be Awarded |
|-------|----------------------------------|---------------------|
| 1.    | Less than 67%                    | 0                   |
| 2.    | More than 67% but less than 70%. | 1                   |
| 3.    | 70% or more but less than 75%.   | 2                   |
| 4.    | 75% or more but less than 80%.   | 3                   |
| 5.    | 80% or more but less than 85%.   | 4                   |
| 6.    | 85% and above.                   | 5                   |

[Medical certificates shall be excluded while calculating credit towards marks to be awarded for attendance, though such certificates shall continue to be taken into account for the purpose of calculating eligibility to appear for examinations as per the existing provisions of Ordinance VII.2.9.(a)(ii).]

It may clearly be noted that Admit Cards shall be issued to the students only on the basis of their attendance as per university rules. The attendance of a student is also required for deciding eligibility criteria for the candidature of the Delhi University Students Union & Sri Venkateswara College Students Union Elections. Only candidates with a minimum of 75% attendance in the preceding year are eligible to contest the elections as per rules.
