NOMINATION PAPER
(Guidelines)

FOR THE OFFICE-BEARERS OF SRI VENKATESWARA COLLEGE STUDENTS UNION & CENTRAL COUNCILLORS OF DUSU 2016-2017.

Instructions :-

1. The Nomination should be filed only in the prescribed form. Nomination filed on any other form or on plain paper shall be considered invalid.
2. The Nomination paper should be filled in and signed in all respects. No column should be left blank. Incomplete forms will be rejected. **The candidates may apply for more than one post but are permitted to finally contest for one post only.**
3. Should have secured minimum 50% aggregate marks in the previous year (2015-2016) at the Delhi University Annual examinations in I Year/II Year (in case of III Year candidates, - 50% aggregate in both I & II Years combined is required) and it is also essential that subsidiary/concurrent/qualifying Examinations are passed, for contesting Sri Venkateswara College Students Union Elections for the post of President, Vice President, Secretary, Joint Secretary and Class Representatives. However, the above mentioned condition of 50% aggregate marks in the previous year examination is not applicable to the contestants for Central Councillors of DUSU.
4. As per the Constitution of the College Students Union, only students with one year standing in the College shall be eligible to contest election for the post of **President** and **Secretary** of the College Students Union viz. the students belonging to II and III Years.
5. The tenure of the **President, Vice President, Secretary, Joint Secretary and Class Representatives will be for one year.**
6. **No student shall be eligible to contest and/or hold a post of Office-Bearer for more than one academic year and in case of Central Councillors of DUSU or Class Representative of the College, this period is restricted to two years. Further, no candidate is allowed to contest for more than one post.**
7. No student having less than 75% of attendance in Theory (including Sports/ECA Attendance, whichever applicable) in the preceding year of the Course shall be allowed to contest for any post of Office-Bearer or Central Councillor of DUSU. However, this condition is not applicable for a student of First Year in the College.
