Brief Information about the Seminar:

Topic / Subject of the Seminar	Lecture on the theme <i>“How can businesses address concerns of Marine Pollution and support in Marine Conservation efforts”</i>
Objectives	The fundamental objective of this event focused primarily on the topic of how businesses can address concerns of marine pollution and support in marine conservation efforts. It has been long observed that the marine environment has been constantly neglected and only recently have they drawn attention due to the extent of damage that our ignorance has caused. 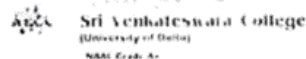

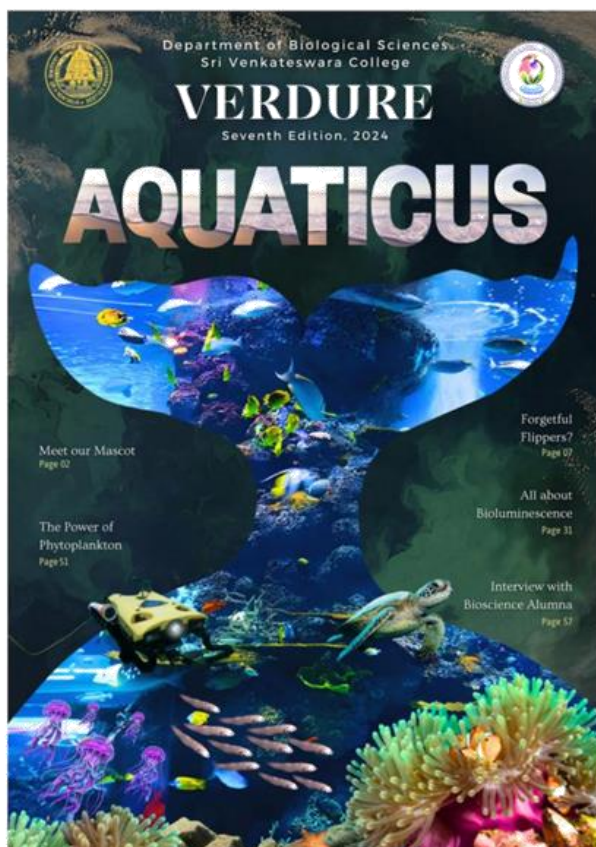

ACTIVITY REPORT

With curiosity-filled minds, eager to delve into the vast ocean of knowledge and information, **Chrysalis**, the Biological Science Society organized its annual departmental fest, **Koshika'24** on 12th March 2024. The fest incorporated three major events, an inaugural lecture on “**How can businesses address concerns of marine pollution and support in marine conservation efforts**” by **Ms. Reela Mishra**, Director, Risk advisory, Deloitte India, the release of the 7th edition of the annual magazine of the department - **Verdure**, and the announcement of the winners of the competitions that were conducted. The event began with dedicating our warm prayers to God with the invocation ceremony, following which a heartfelt welcome to the guests, leachers, and participants was extended. The event-in-charge, Dr. Rajendra Phartyal gave an introduction to our honorary guest lecturer Ms. Reela Mishra. The event was held in an offline mode and was attended by more than 150 participants, including staff and students.

The event kicked off with the **unveiling of the 7th edition of Verdure**, the annual magazine of the Department of Biological Sciences. This was followed by a short video that provided a sneak peek into the magazine.


Ms.Reela Mishra initiated the talk by giving an insight into Deloitte India and her own experience with the firm. After the introduction, she started the discussion on the topic at hand with a small video. The video showcased the journey of a used plastic bottle that is frivolously thrown by humans, and it ends up in the water bodies, contaminating them and further having lethal effects on the biodiversity. The discussion proceeded and she talked about what marine pollution was which included its UN definition and what were the plausible reasons for it. She gave an example of accidental oil spills that have occurred in recent times and have led to devastating consequences like the deep-water Horizon oil spill in 2010 and the Sundarbans oil spill in 2014. The different kinds of maritime industries like shipping and transport, offshore oil and gas exploration and production, marine tourism and recreation, such as scuba diving and snorkeling have caused repercussions in terms of the sustenance of a healthy environment for the ocean dwellers. Climate change also happens to be a major reason for the loss of marine biodiversity for example marine heatwaves and ocean acidification have fatal implications. Talking about marine pollution and its impacts, Ms. Reela informed about 85% of the total marine waste is plastic. Over one-third of marine mammals and one-third of sharks and reef-forming corals are threatened with extinction due to the ill impacts of pollution. As the next slide pulls up, it informs us of the regulatory landscape laid through the years. Formation of UNEP and the establishment of the MPA in 1972, and several different conventions like the MARPOL convention that focused on shaping the rules and regulations around pollution control from ships for preserving the marine environment and biodiversity conservation. The concluding topics incorporated the details on various global voluntary standards and frameworks which had to be conformed to by companies and agencies. Examples of these frameworks are the TNFD. SBTN, Global Reporting Initiative among many others. The objective of making businesses aware of all the risks and concerns so that they shifted to more responsible ocean practices was emphasized up on. Ms. Reela also highlighted the importance of collaborating to develop and implement innovative initiatives and programs at the ground level to achieve substantial change and positive results in reaching the goals. The lecture was followed by a Q&A session, where the teachers and students asked several thoughtful questions regarding the role of students in marine conservation and how the current businesses were holding up to the frameworks and policies for conservation.

Dr. Pamil Tayal, the teacher in charge of Chrysalis, presented the vote of thanks to our esteemed speaker before she called upon Ms. Aashleshaa, Student Coordinator of Chrysalis, to announce the winner of the competition "The one where the Nature Talks - Comics for a Cause. The three best entries were felicitated by Ms. Reela Mishra and Dr. Jayaraj, teacher in charge of Verdure who was also the judge for this competition.

The next was the announcement of the winners of "Visual reflections a photostory contest". Ms. Arshdeep and Ms. Aprajita student Coordinators of Chrysalis, announced the winners who had clicked beautiful pictures of natural events and also read out the stories behind. Dr. Robin Suyesh the judge for this competition along with our guest speaker Ms. Reela Mishra presented the winners with certificates. The vote of thanks by Mr. Arjun Student Coordinator of Chrysalis, and this concluded the event with everyone proceeding for high tea.

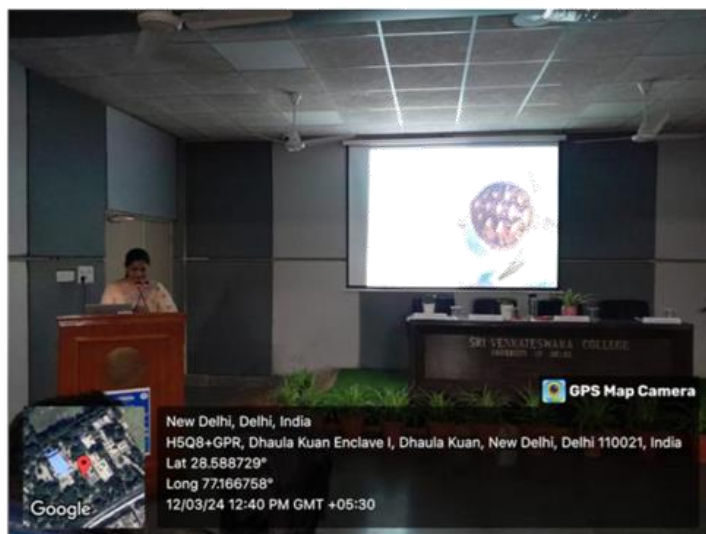

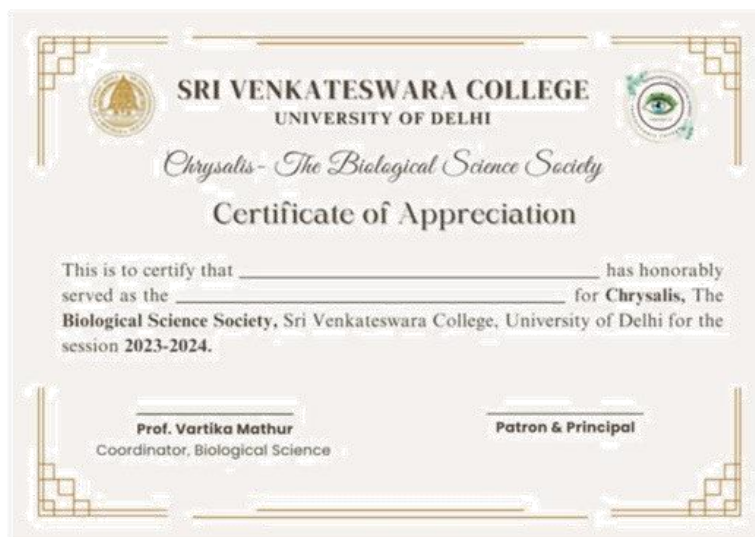


