#### Name of the Event: Richie Rich

Date: 23rd April, 2024

Venue: Seminar Hall

"Richie Rich" was a life-sized version of the popular board game Monopoly and was the main event of the day. The participants were informed in advance and arrived at the venue by 12:30. The game had two rounds: The first round was conducted online on Unstop, where teams had to register and answer a rapid-fire round with questions of moderate difficulty. The second round was offline and held on campus. The game had five laps, and instead of rolling dice, different games were played, such as guessing the movie through emojis, naming companies starting from a particular letter, or choosing a representative to roll the dice for a team. Four teams faced each other, and at the end of the event, the winners were decided by calculating the net worth of each team. The net worth was calculated by adding the balance left of the initial sum provided to each team of \$12,000 and the value of assets purchased by them.

## Name of the Event: The Football Auction

Date: 23rd April, 2024

The ComSoc conducted its event "**The Football Auction**" on April 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2024. Mr. Madhav Kaushal extended a warm welcome to the arriving participants for the competition.

#### **ROUND 1 - (Quiz Round)**

In the first round, an online quiz featuring football-related questions was conducted on unstop, and 16 selected teams went to the next round.

## **ROUND 2 - (FIFA Penalty)**

Following that, a one-on-one FIFA Penalty competition took place on a play station within the campus for the second round, with eight teams moving on to the final round. Each team was given a chance to choose the club randomly by chit picking process.

#### **ROUND 3 - (The Bidding Round)**




The event was marked by intense rivalry as teams utilized their football expertise to engage in fierce battle of bids, creating a memorable experience.

Name of the Event: "Basics of Investing and More" by Harsh Goela, founder of Goela School of Finance"

Date: 24th April, 2024

Venue: Seminar Hall

The event began with a welcome address by Stuti Grover, the Vice President of the Commerce Association. She then introduced the keynote speaker, Mr. Harsh Goela. The Convenor of the Commerce Association, Dr. Vinod Kumar, and a faculty member of the Commerce department also greeted the students and the esteemed speaker. Mr. Goela, the founder of Goela School of Finance, then delivered an enlightening seminar on the basics of investment and more. He shared many financial instruments and stories, and discussed the reality, risks, and opportunities of stock markets, as well as the myths about real estate investments. He also explained the difference between considering gold an investment or an insurance. The speaker emphasized that in India, gold is considered as an investment, whereas in reality, it is the best hedge against inflation as gold is a currency. He further explained how different economies pump money into their system to boost growth and discussed the impact of high and low interest rates on an economy. He also emphasized the benefits of having a considerable holding period of stocks for current and aspiring traders. The seminar was truly enlightening as Mr. Goela shared his personal experiences as a trader. The event concluded with an interactive question-answer session with the students present.

#### Name of the Event: Panel Discussion on "Exploring the Integration of AI across Industries and Strategies"

Date: 24<sup>th</sup> April, 2024

Venue: Seminar Hall

The Panel Discussion began with a welcome address from Chaitanya Aggarwal, Joint Secretary of The Commerce Association, who introduced the panelists: CA Sunil Pathak, Mrs. Mrinal Gupta, Mr. Saurav Mishra, Rahul Lakhmani, and Dr. Vineeta Mishra. The panelists were presented with planters by the teachers of The Commerce Department. The discussion began with the panelists addressing the key challenges they encountered in integrating AI into their respective fields. Mrinal Gupta and Vineeta Mishra highlighted how AI facilitated their work while cautioning against its limitations in evaluation tasks. Saurav Mishra discussed how AI had enhanced auditing and commerce, emphasizing its inability to replace human intelligence. Sunil Pathak expressed concerns about the potential job displacement due to AI, presenting contradictory views. Rahul Lakhmani praised the benefits of AI while advocating for cautious use. The report describes the discussion as enlightening, concluding with the notion that future generations would devise their own methods to adapt to AI's presence. The panel discussion ended with a Q&A session involving the attending students.



Mode of Conduction: Online


