<b>TOPIC/SUBJECT OF THE ACTIVITY</b>	<b>COMFLUENCE-24 (Bi-Annual Fest)</b>
<b>OBJECTIVES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To explore India's economic growth trajectory and its potential to become a \$10 trillion economy.</li><li>• To replicate real time stock trading and investment strategies.</li><li>• To figure out a made-up crime using clues and reasoning.</li></ul>
<b>METHODOLOGY</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The speaker session delivered by Mr. Subhash Chandra Garg, revolved around the issue of India's economic development which was looking into important areas like technology and infrastructure. It ended with an interactive Question and Answer session in which participants were able to probe into some of the relevant economic issues.</li><li>• Vyapaar-Verse- The event featured participants pretending to participate in real-life market trading. Utilizing the data, they made trade decisions, controlled their exposure, and adjusted to new market conditions. The event created a competitive atmosphere and developed the financial competence of the participants. The participants were exposed to various dynamic market situations where they participated in Market ups and downs, risk management and making financial decisions. It allowed participants to trade practically understanding the market dynamics and the behaviour of the investors.</li><li>• Knives Out- The event engaged the audience in fake criminal case proceedings where the interpretation of evidence and relations with the suspects were the main tasks. The teams worked towards gathering the props and the evidence in places, questioning the several suspects and then creating details on how the event occurred. The activity assessed the degree of logical reasoning as well as the degree of teamwork exhibited by the teams. Teams of players analysed the evidence, questioned the suspects, and worked out the mystery in order to catch the murderer. The contest involved critical thinking, teamwork, and skills as to how best one can be</li></ul>

	precise in a dark adventure-like experience.

**Date: 22nd October, 2024**

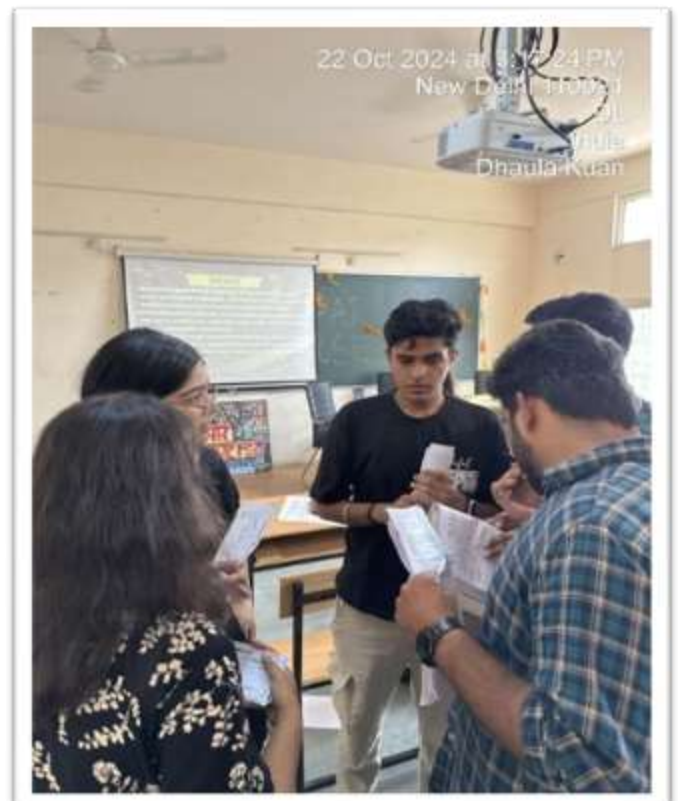
**Venue: 321, Durgabhai Deshmukh Block**

**Date: 22<sup>nd</sup> October, 2024**

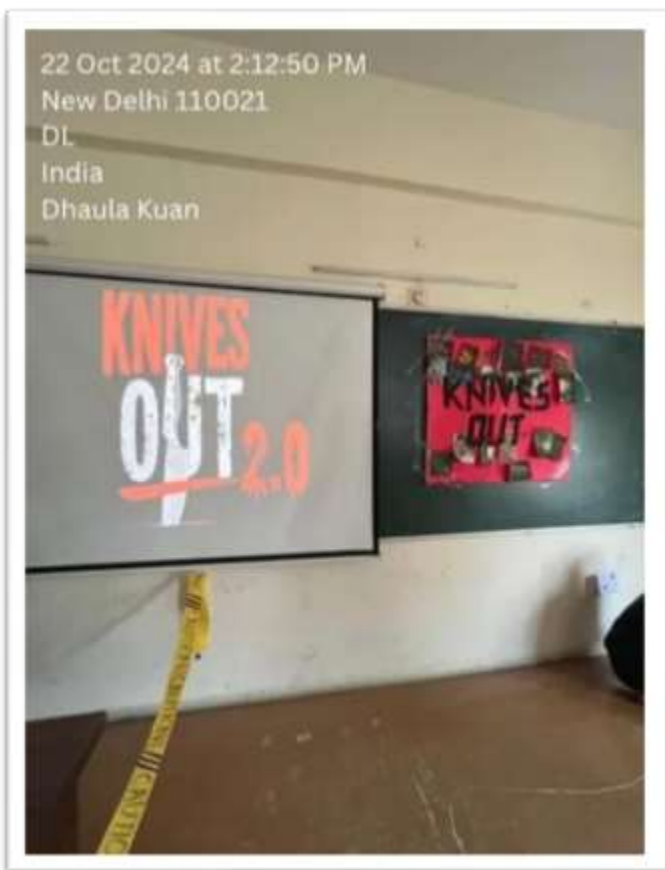
**Venue: 322, Durgabhai Deshmukh Block**


