

#### Election Guidelines

#### 1. Eligibility to Vote

We are pleased to invite all students currently enrolled in the Political Science department to participate in the upcoming election. To vote, please **present one of the following** valid forms of identification: an official **Identity Card issued by the college or a Fee Slip**. Kindly note that only students who are physically present on the day of voting will be able to cast their votes, as **absentee voting is not permitted**.

### 2. Campaign Period and Methods

Campaigning is encouraged and will be allowed until September 24, 2024, by 5:00 PM. Candidates are welcome to use social media and interact face-to-face to connect with voters. We request that all campaigns follow ethical standards, focus on policy discussions, and maintain respect towards opponents. Please note that campaigning will only be permitted up to the specified campaign period.

All candidates are expected to communicate with one another and with voters respectfully and professionally. Intimidation, personal attacks, or spreading false information about opponents are prohibited. Campaign materials, including posters, flyers, and online content, should be respectful and free from offensive or inappropriate language or imagery.

# 3. Voting Speeches

On election day, September 25, 2024, starting at 10:00 A.M., all candidates are invited to deliver a speech. This includes candidates running unopposed. Each speech should be concise, lasting no more than 2 minutes. This is to be followed by one question per speech.

# 4. Presidential Debate

A debate for the positions of President and Vice President will be held on Election Day. Candidates for these positions will be given 3 minutes for an opening speech, followed by a 3-minute presidential debate. Additionally, there will be a questioning round where the audience can pose questions to the candidates. The questioning round shall last for not more than 2 minutes.

# 5. Voting Process

Voting will take place via a ballot system on September 25, 2024. The votes will be counted on the same day in front of the candidates, and the results will be released as soon as the counting finishes.

#### 6. Code of Conduct for Candidates

We kindly remind all candidates and their supporters to adhere to the following guidelines:


- · Use of threats, coercion, or bribes to influence votes is strictly prohibited.
- Discrimination of any kind, including based on race, religion, gender, disability, or other personal characteristics, is not acceptable. An Equity committee will be setup to look after such cases.
- Defamation against any candidate is not allowed and will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Any disputes or grievances should be formally submitted to the Election Committee for resolution.
- Violations of the Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary actions, including disqualification and potential suspension from future elections.
- We appreciate your cooperation and wish everyone the best of luck in the election process.
