Towards environmental conservation and enhancing the cleanliness of Sanjay Van was taken through a mega cleanliness drive, organized by "There is no Earth B" and Eco Club Sri Venkateswara College on 19th March 2023, Sunday at Sanjay Van, Delhi. Around 26 students of SVC accompanied by Dr. Pankaj Kumar, actively participated in this initiative.

The primary objective of the drive was the removal of non-biodegradable waste from the park, aligning with goals related to waste disposal, plastic waste management, and sanitation. Reusable gloves, sacks, and ploughing sticks were distributed to facilitate effective waste collection and maintain a sustainable approach.

The participation of over 100 volunteers from various colleges, including SVC, played a vital role in the event's success. An impressive 285.5 kg of plastic waste was successfully removed from Sanjay Van, significantly contributing to the event's overall impact.






