The Y20 Chaupal took place on 24<sup>th</sup> April 2023 at the Amphitheatre of TERI SAS, from 6:00 PM to 7:00 PM. This was an open-air peer-to-peer discussion event where 06 students of our college from different courses (B.Sc. (H) Mathematics, B.Sc. (H) Biological Sciences, and B.Sc. Life Sciences) accompanied by Dr. Pankaj Kumar, Department of Environmental Sciences, participated to explore the role of youth climate leadership in accelerating low-carbon initiatives at the subnational level.

The event provided a platform for students from various institutions, young professionals, and fellows from different states to engage in meaningful conversations about the crucial role of youth in addressing climate change. With the participation of State Climate Fellows and the Climate Group India team as moderators, the discussion focused on select thematic areas that are pertinent to youth climate action in India.






